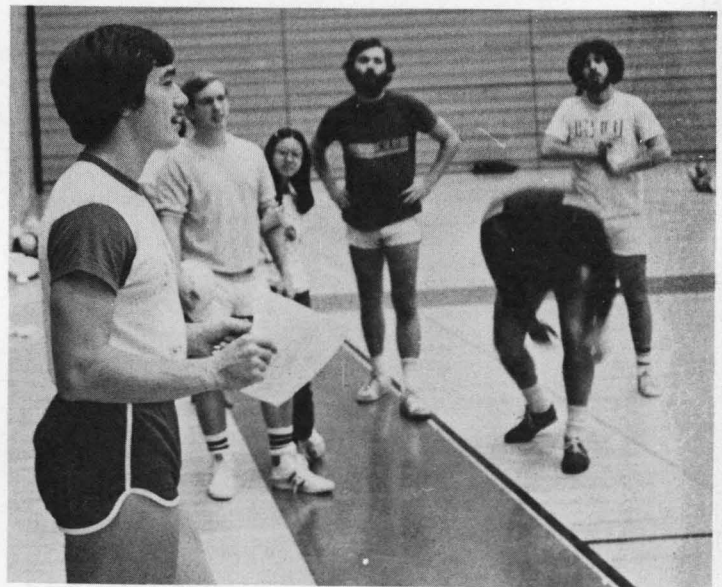

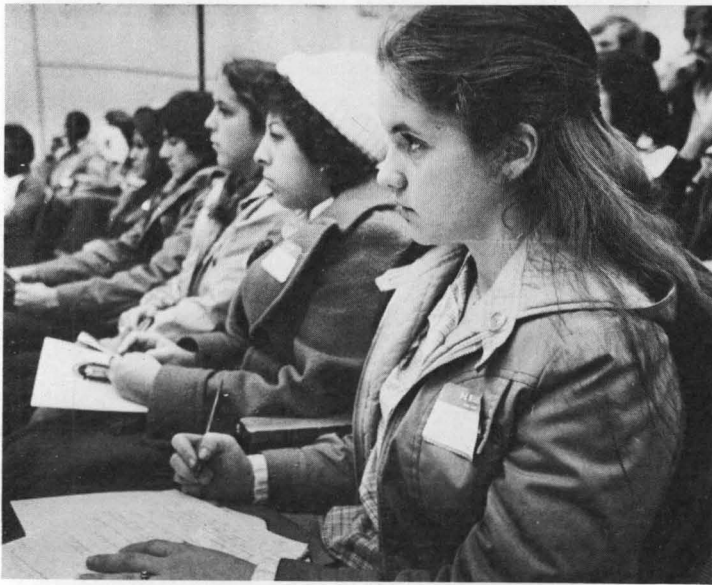

CSUH SPORTS HIGHLIGHTS

The 1979/80 marked another season for Cal-State intercollegiate athletics.

With the spring sports still in progress, the Pioneers have won one National Title in Woman's Cross-Country, and captured the Far Western Conference Title in Soccer, while placing third in both Men's and Women's Swimming and in Men's Cross-Country.

FOOTBALL

The 1979 football season turned to be less successful than hoped. Suffering an 0-5 conference record and a 1-9 overall record, the Pioneers are looking towards next year to get back on the winning track. Despite the bad record, the team was led by some outstanding individual performances. Middle linebacker John Locke, who led the defense in tackles, was named to the All-Far-Western Conference team, along with defensive-end Mark Candelario and safety Jay Shipe.

MEN'S WATER POLO

After placing in the top three in the past eight years, the Pioneers had to settle for fourth place this year in the FWC with an 1-5 record, 7-20 overall. Scott Saracco, Chris Amaral, and goalie Steve Victorson were selected for first team FWC. Mike Leslie and Bill Burns were selected for second team. Scott Saracco led the club in scoring with 76 goals, while Chris Amaral had 63.

SOCCKER

The Pioneer soccer team turned it around during the 1979 season winning the Far Western Conference (FWC) with a 4-1-1 mark and going 9-6-2 overall. Four Pioneers were selected to first team All-Far-Western Conference, goalie Tracey Wyatt, halfbacks, Levi Andrew and Steve Biddle, and defenseman Eric Nyberg. Colin Lindores, in his fourth season as soccer coach, was voted Coach of the Year.

MEN'S CROSS-COUNTRY

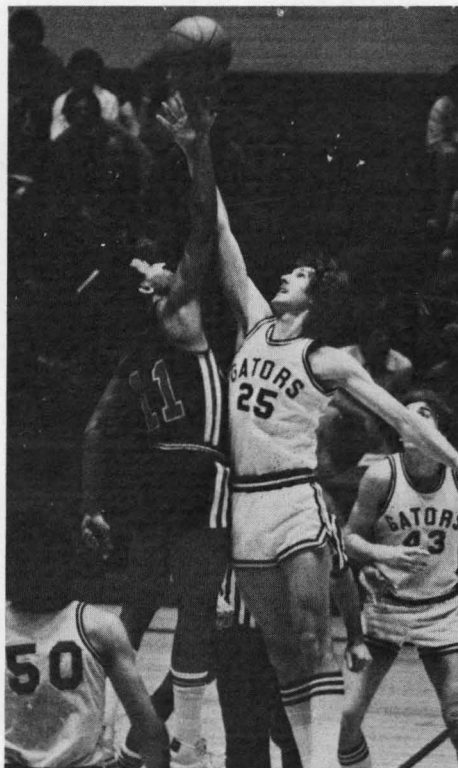
The Pioneers completed its most successful season ever, finishing third in the FWC Championship. Matt Dowling was Cal State's finisher placing 17th, running the 10,000 meter course in 32:07, Paul Sechrist placed 18th (32:11) and Mike Chastaine 21st (32:21)

WOMEN'S CROSS-COUNTRY

In only their second year of existence, the Women's Cross-Country team captured the Golden State Conference title, the WIAAW Regional Championship and the AIAW Division III National Championships. Michelle Aubuchon once again led the team placing 3rd in the Division. Michelle and Connie Hester earned All American Honors for their fine performances.

MEN'S BASKETBALL

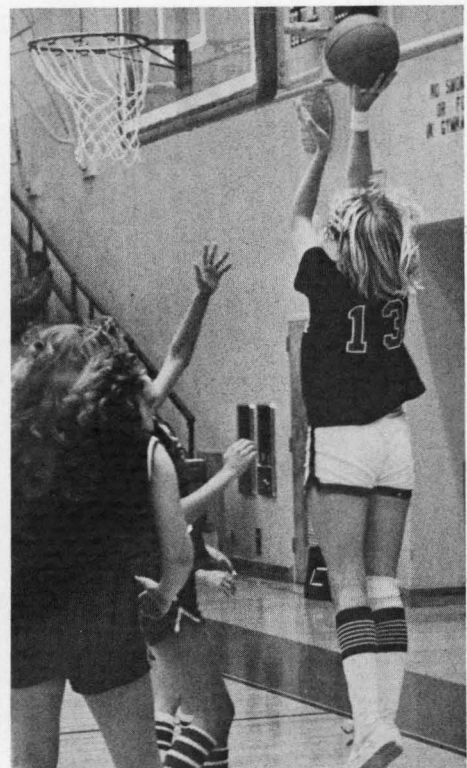
The men's basketball team went through a disappointing season, finishing sixth in the FWC with a 3-9 record, 9-18 overall. Grantland Bailey led the team in scoring, averaging 12.3 points a game, while Charles Gibson averaged 11.8 points and over 10 rebounds per game. Terry Hobson, who played the second half of the season, was third on the club in scoring, averaging 11 points per game and was named to the second team All-Far-Western Conference.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Following in the footsteps of the men's basketball team, the women's squad also suffered a losing season. Finishing with a 4-10 record in Golden State Conference play, 7-20 overall, they finished in sixth place. The top performers were Janice Knudsen and Vicki Hannaford, both of whom were named Honorable Mention to the GSC team.

WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL

The Pioneers finished seventh in the GSC but showed improvement over last season. With a team comprised of freshmen and sophomores, the Pioneers will be a contender for the crown next season.

WOMEN'S GYMNASTICS

The 1979/80 campaign saw the Pioneer gymnastics team placing third in the GSC Championships and in the top ten at the recent Nationals. Holly Moore and Nancy Herneon were Cal State's top performers this season, averaging 33 and 32 points in all around. Cal State also received solid efforts from Betsy Skellenger and Irene Hanson.

MEN'S & WOMEN'S SWIMMING

The Pioneers finished third in their respective conferences, (FWC—men, GSC—women), receiving tremendous individual performances. The women's team, led by Olivia Moore, Pam Williams, and Peggy Barker, plus diver Laurie Stilson, won 5 of 6 GSC duel meets. The one loss was a narrow two-point defeat to UC Davis, which snapped a winning streak dated back to the 1977/78 season.

The men performed well, paced by free-styler Darrell Rucker and back-stroker George Osterberg, who holds school and conference records in the 100 and 200 back stroke.

WOMEN'S SOFTBALL

The 1980 softball team shapes up to be one of the best in the school's history. Cal State got off to a winning start defeating Santa Clara, 5-4. The Pioneers should be in the race for the GSC crown.

WOMEN'S TENNIS

A more experienced club should enable the Pioneers to place in the top four of the GSC this season. Coach Marge Martin is optimistic of a high finish after the Pioneer's first four matches in the early going.

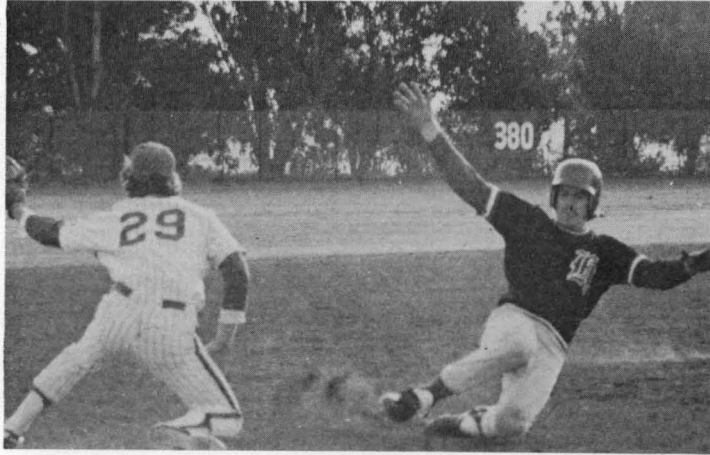

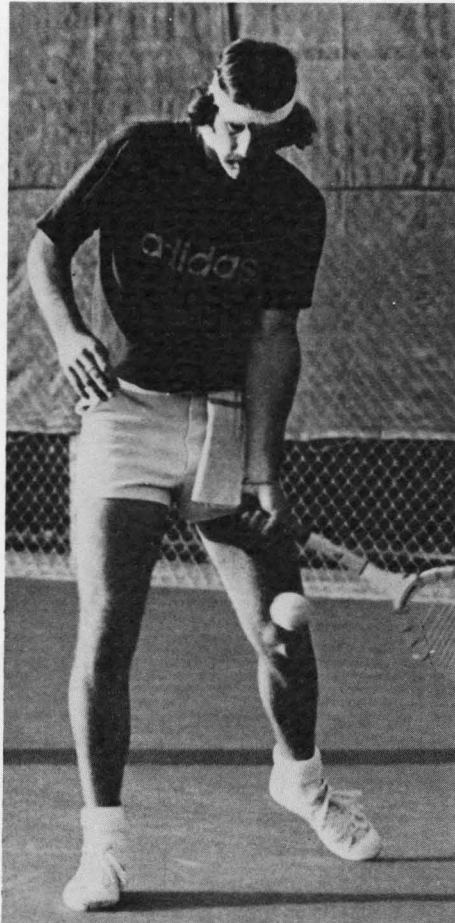

MEN'S TENNIS

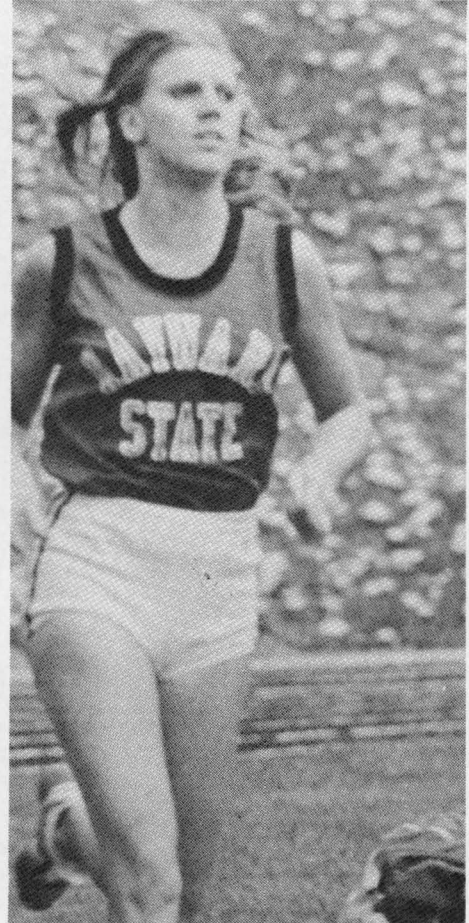

WOMEN'S TRACK

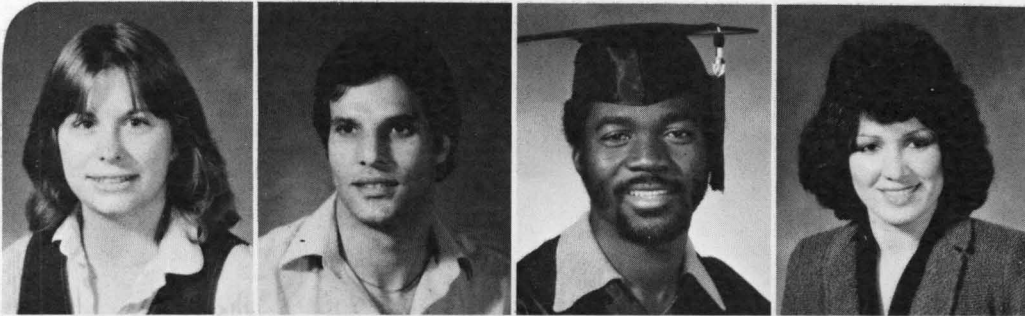
