SPECIAL PATRON LETTERS: Lorraine Pankratz presented drafts of letters addressed to former awardees and business and professional women, inviting them to attend the banquet as patrons. Letters were edited and approved for mailing. Dixie Adeniran will provide a list of business and professional women's organizations and addresses to facilitate mailing.
