1. THE ACADEMIC ADVISING AND PREREGISTRATION PERIOD FOR CONTINUING STUDENTS has been changed from 23 April through 2 May to 7-18 May, 1979.
2. TIME BLOCK REVISION. On 4 April 1979, the College Council unanimously recommended the adoption of the attached time block effective with the Fall term 1979-80. The recommendation was approved by President Frankel on 6 April 1979.
3. NEW DEAN OF EDUCATION. As announced on the Faculty Meeting on 11 April, Dr. Deborah Osen Hancock has been appointed the new Dean of the School of Education effective 1 September 1979. She replaces Dean Jim Whitley who returns to the Department of Physical Education at the end of the summer.
