



TEAGUE HAS EXPERIENCE

Congressman Teague has been your representative in Washington for 14 years. Ventura Marina breakwater and Port Hueneme Harbor projects.


RESULTS! Teague actively supports conservation resulting in the designation of exciting wilderness areas such as San Rafael.

WHERE TEAGUE STANDS

TEAGUE SUPPORTS:

National strength through such measures as expanded missile programs, broadened aerospace efforts, Defense Department reorganization and a mutual security program. Congressman Teague's support of these goals has continuously been beneficial to the people of his home district, helping to create a healthier economy and new job opportunities through military and industrial expansion at and near Vandenberg Air Force Base, Port Hueneme Naval Base, Oxnard Air Force Base, Point Mugu Missile Center and other installations throughout the District.

In the area of human rights, Teague's voting record on social legislation shows support of 1) improved minimum wage laws, including farm labor; 2) wage increases for postal employees and other government workers; 3) cost of living increases in Social Security payments to our older citizens; 4) increased compensation to disabled veterans; 5) Medicare; and 6) civil rights, except compulsory "open housing".

TEAGUE IS FIRMLY AGAINST:

Aggression and attempted communist subversion of sovereign countries, as shown by his deep concern for the preservation of Asian and Southeast Asian independence. Teague firmly supports a three-pronged approach to our Vietnam policy, including: 1) de-Americanizing the war; 2) strengthening the South Vietnamese government; and 3) the active pursuit of diplomatic conferences with the enemy that will form the framework for legitimate peace talks.

Teague is against deficit government spending. He believes that, except in the case of a national emergency, the government must remain within its budget. In his position on the House Agriculture Committee, Teague's votes have always been aimed at holding down essential food prices and eliminating farm subsidies.

Chuck Teague was born in Santa Paula and educated in the Santa Paula public schools. He graduated from Stanford University in 1931 and from Stanford Law School in 1934, and served for 4 years in World War II. Before being elected to Congress in 1954, he practiced law in Ventura. In 1947, he served as president of the Ventura Rotary Club, and in 1949 and 1950, as President of the Ventura County Community Chest. For several years he was President of the Board of Trustees for the Ojai Valley School.

Teague's 14 years in Congress and his seniority on important committees, plus his lifelong knowledge of his District, make him ideally qualified to continue as our representative in the important years ahead.
