INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRECINCT WORKERS

- 1. Cross off the Republicans "A" on this list.
- 2. Put the phone numbers next to the Democrats and the "Decline to State" which are marked with "C".
- 3. Write the names, addresses and phone numbers of the Democrats on duplistickers and arrange them in street order

 One (1) street per page, the odds on the left and the even on the right. This is a walking list.
- 4. On election day, November 8th, telephone all the Democrats and "C" saying you are a volunteer Democrat urging him to vote. Ask the person if he knows the address of his polling place or needs help in getting to the poll. Call Headquarters Hunter 7-1412 or Hunter 7-2616 if a ride is needed. Be pleasant and brief.
- 5. At 4 P. M. go to the polling place and cross off all the people who have voted. The precinct list hanging on the front of the polling place has the names crossed off every hour till 4 P. M.
- 6. Cross these names off the walking list too and concentrate on phoning and going house to house.

Try to find a person in your precinct, a working man who can take over at 3 or 4 would be good, who is willing to go door to door to those without phones and who can go to the polling place to check off those who have voted. If you are this person find some one to help you phone half of the list and follow up the 4 P. M. checkoff with phone calls while you go door to door.

If you are unable to find a person to do this call Headquarters, Mrs. Shearer, Hunter 7-1412, before election, and she will have someone to help you.
