

This Contract made this 25th day of Sept. 1903, by and between R.E. Jack party of the first part, and Samuel Sanborn party of the second part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the agreements and stipulations hereinafter specified the parties hereto agree as follows. Whereas said party of the second part knows of certain lands, valuable for petroleum oil, and that the parties hereto desire to acquire said lands, and leaseholds and rights therein.

Said party of the first part hereby agrees to secure bonds for the purchase of certain lands in T.26 S. R. 17 & 18 E. on the most favorable terms to the parties hereto, and he further agrees that said party of the second part shall have an equal interest with said party of the first part in all lands, bonds, leaseholds, and other contracts, on all such lands, in consideration of which said party of the second part, hereby agrees to, help in securing all such lands, bonds, leaseholds and other contracts thereon and to secure such as he can without the aid of

said party of the first part, and that said party of the first part shall have an equal interest in all such lands, bonds, leaseholds, and other contracts so obtained by said party of the second part.

It is further agreed and stipulated by and between the parties hereto, that this contract may be terminated by either party hereto, by giving notice to the other in writing, and that all business ^{done by} either party after said notice shall be independent of this contract.
