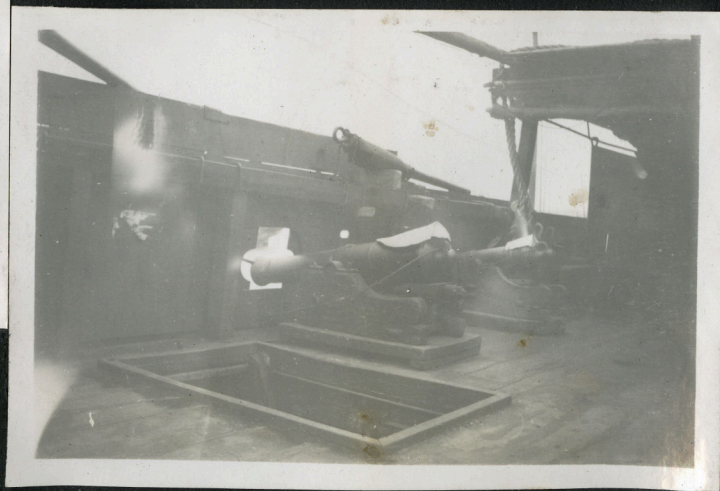

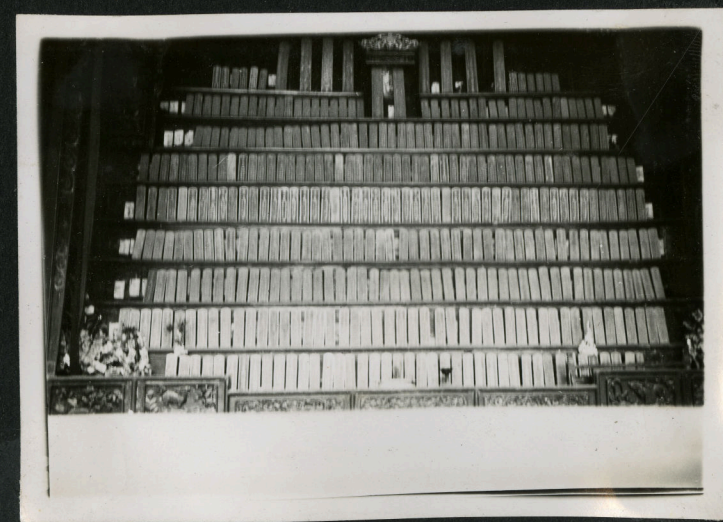

25th of a second in time
 opening at II . (Note distant
 objects blurred)
 Distance 10 feet
 focus on placards



Time $\frac{1}{25}$ opening II Distance 15 feet
 The post that was blurred in the
 first picture comes into focus, but
 not sharply.



Time $\frac{1}{25}$ opening II Distance 25 ft.
 The post is in focus and sharp. The
 post is 25 ft. away. - Distant objects blurred



Smoke from firecrackers.

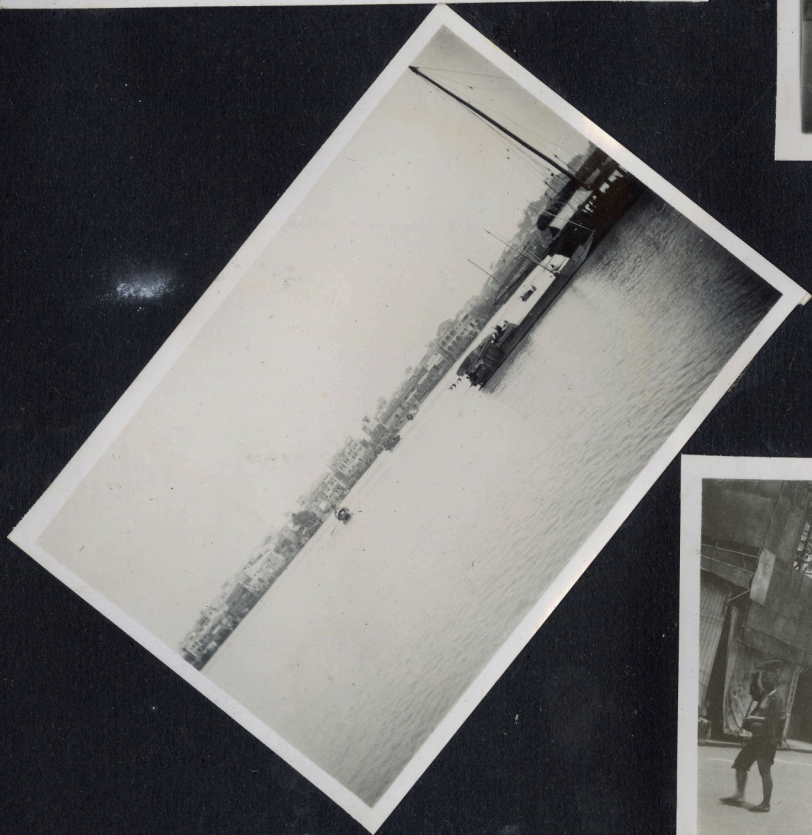


Time $\frac{1}{25}$ opening 22 Distance 15 ft.
 Stopping down to smallest opening, 22 ,
 brings distant objects into focus.
