Subject: Measure "A" Committee Status Report and Recommendations

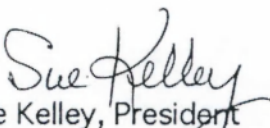
Dear Board Members,

The League of Women Voters and the Sustainability Council of Ventura County both support the implementation of Measure A. Many other organizations also support its implementation. Therefore, we commend the Measure A Committee's continuing efforts to outline strategies that fulfill Measure A. It is our hope that the Board will endorse the Committee's recommended actions as an initial effort in the long-term implementation of a ballot measure that enjoys broad public support.

The League and the Sustainability Council are pleased to join with the Board in the promotion and presentation of an informational program on Urban Growth Boundaries (UBGs) and related issues.
