CineCulture film, workshop looks at changing Earth, Mar. 22-23

Fresno State's CineCulture program partnered with the Women's International League for Peace & Freedom to host the league's first stop on its California Environmental Guardianship Tour. The first event is a screening of the film "Chasing Ice," 5:30 p.m. Friday, March 22 in the Leon S. and Pete P. Peters Educational Center in the Student Recreation Center.
