Japanese print of any kind directed to evacuees and transmitted by U.S. Mail will be turned over by Center Postal authorities to the internal police at each Assembly Center for delivery to the evacuees. Center Post Office authorities will notify the addressees of the disposition of the articles and the evacuees may take delivery of such from the Center police. Upon completion of delivery, Center police will immediately ^{also} relieve the evacuees of the articles delivered.
