# FUNDS LISTED FOR ACADEMY

Operation of the California Maritime Academy for the 1958-59 fiscal year is set at \$417,073 in Governor Knight's budget submitted today to the Legislature.

Although it represents an increase of \$18,136, or 4.5 per cent over the current year, only \$26,187 is asked for capital outlay.

The amount provides for dredging the boat basin at an estimated cost of \$6,187 and the construction of outdoor physical education facilities at \$20,000.

The budget is based on an expected enrollment of 200, up 25 from this year and up 49 from 1956-57. It is anticipated the Academy will operate at full capacity in 1958-59 for the first time.

Two instructional positions and a librarian are proposed as staff additions. The Department of Finance said it was hoped addition of an adequate library would permit accreditation of the Academy.

The budget shows \$383,942 for salaries and wages; \$159,364 for operating expense; and \$3,850 for equipment.
