Cohort Analysis of Upper-Division Undergraduate Transfers Continuously Enrolled Students by Semester: Fall 02 through Fall 07



The purpose of this report is to identify and track Upper-division Transfers (UDTs) for the purpose of understanding continuous enrollment. This document tracks five cohorts of UDTs across multiple semesters of continuous enrollment; and identifies the sixth cohort as follows:

Cohort 1 (Fa02 thru Fa07); Cohort 2 (Fa03 thru Fa07); Cohort 3 (Fa04 thru Fa07); Cohort 4 (Fa05 thru Fa07); Cohort 5 (Fa06 thru Fa07); and Cohort 6 (Fa07)

A generalized pattern of enrollment behavior across the four cohorts has emerged and is highlighted on the printout. For analytical purposes, the data suggests the following constants for UDTs can be calculated: the rate from 1st Fall to 1st Spring continuous enrollment is .90595; the rate from 1st Spring to 2nd Fall is .90068; and the one-year rate from 1st Fall to 2nd Fall is .81591.
