Over 80 artists from all over California and beyond, will display and sell their works of art in the quad behind Studio Channel Islands Art Center on Friday August 4th from 5 to 8 p.m., and on Saturday, August 5th from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. The juried art event will be open to patrons of the Opening Night Gala as well as the ticket holders for the general admission, music only. On Saturday, the Artists in Residence at Studio Channel Islands Art Center will welcome attendees to browse through the selections of artwork and meet and greet the artists. An additional Artwalk will be set up in Old Town Camarillo on the sidewalks and within businesses along Ventura Boulevard as well as in Dizdar Park, all day Saturday. Attending artists will exhibits works of arts in watercolors, oils, wearable art, tapestry, jewelry, photography, ceramics and much more.
