There were 32 children born to Japanese evacuees while interned at Fresno Assembly Center according to the Western Defense Command Final Report. The publications issued at Fresno Center during the period of Japanese occupation reveal the family names of twenty-four mothers and the sex of the child born. The eight children ~~un~~ unaccounted for were probably born during the several weeks prior to the transfer of evacuees to Relocation Centers. This was when the publications ceased due to the need for packing of printing equipment for shipment to the Relocation Center. The first ~~five~~ ^{five} children born while mothers were interned at Fresno Center were delivered at the Fresno County Hospital outside the confines of the Center. Here is the date, sex and Mother's name of the ~~four~~ ^{five}.

Saturday May 23, 1942 - Boy - Mrs. Utaka Shitanishi

Sunday May 24, 1942 - Girl - Mrs. Harloy Nakamura.

Tuesday June 2, 1942 - Boy - Mrs. James Imahara.
