As you know, abortion is a major political and social issue in the United States today.

One of the functions of the California Pro-Life Council is to compile information as to where candidates for public office stand on this important issue. This information is then disseminated through our affiliates on the local level.

The enclosed questionnaire on abortion is being sent to all candidates for federal and state legislative office.

Please fill out the questionnaire and return it to us at the above address by April ~~14~~²², 1976.

In preparing our candidate profiles, we also take into account such factors as voting records, sponsorship of legislation, and public statements. In most cases, however, the candidate's response to this questionnaire will be the single most important factor. Where other substantive information is lacking, a candidate's failure to respond may be reported in his profile.

There is only one question in our questionnaire, and it focuses on the central objective of the Pro-Life movement: A constitutional amendment to restore the right to life.

Such an amendment has come to be known as a Human Life Amendment.

Because various proposals for a Human Life Amendment are now before Congress, we have not posed our question in the language of any specific proposal. For your information, however, we have printed on the back of this letter the actual wording of the key proposals which have been submitted to Congress.
