-WHAT DID HE SAY!?!? LAST ISSUE???? Yeah. More on that later. First, I want to thank all the folks who sent letters or wrote reviews raving about issue #4, the candy bag issue. That issue has had my best critical response to date, and, feeling encouraged, I've sent it in to be considered for the Ignatz Award for Outstanding Mini-Comic. So if it makes the ballot, I expect all y'all that can make it to This year's SPX to vote me in.

I do want to respond to one review, if I may. In the June issue (#193) of MAXIMUMROCKNROLL, Brianna Chesser wrote a brief review in which, along with positive comments, she called the Sid Ska story racist, because I chose to have the Hiroshima Customs agents slur their R's and L's.

SINCE WHEN IS IT RACIST TO TRY AND ACCURATELY DEPICT AN ACCENT? I try hard to compose my word balloons so that the reader can get the best impression of the voice I give my characters. I use bold face and underlines to indicate inflection and cadence, and where necessary I will use slang and/or contractions, etc. to indicate how a character's ethnicity influences his/her speech pattern. In the story in question, I was trying to convey the effect of a person of Asian descent struggling with phonems for which his tongue never developed a sense memory. I was only depicting an accent I've heard from every person of Asian descent I've ever met, save for those raised in an English-speaking environment, or those who have taking great pains to retrain their speech muscles. I give her a thick Franglais to show that she's a French fashion model, because otherwise, people might think she's an alien with those things sticking out of her head. (They're Hairpins!) If that's racist, I blame the RICHIE RICH comics I grew up reading. Chef Pierre always spoke like zat!

Believe me, I did think about the decision to use the Japanese accent. I remember once asking Ben Edlund about his use of a similar accent for the character R'ir Nip in one of the early TICK comics. He gave a good explanation that I accepted, and understand all too well now that I am on the creative end.



Maybe I'm an Equal Opportunity Offender.
