CMA Whaleboat Crew Will Race

A squad of oarsmen will represent California Maritime Academy Saturday in the annual whaleboat races on the Maritime Day program at San Francisco's Aquatic Park.

This was announced last night by Lt. Cmdr. William Aguilar, USNR (Ret.), coach of the whaleboat racing squad.

Aguilar's CMAers won the crown several years ago, and always have finished near the top in their division.

There will be two divisions of competition Saturday, at 1 and 2 p.m. The opening International Lifeboat Race field will include crews representing: American President Line, Crown Zellerbach Corp., Matson Navigation, Military Sea Transportation Service, Pacific Far East Line, Standard Oil Co. of California, States Steamship Co. and J. H. Winchester Co.

SQUAD NAMED

The CMA will have a team rowing the 26-foot whaleboats in the Propeller Club Trophy race at 2 p.m. Others in the field will include: Dolphin Swim and Boat Club, Marine Air Reserve Training Detachment, Mt. Diablo Council Boy Scouts, San Francisco Bay Area Council Boy Scouts, San Mateo County Council Boy Scouts, Alameda Coast Guard, and U. S. Merchant Marine Academy Alumni Association.

The races will be over a distance of three-quarters of a mile.
