Assembly Speaker Jesse M. Unruh today released the list of delegates who will make up California's 174-vote delegation to the Democratic National Convention in Chicago.

The delegation includes 25 new members whom Unruh appointed to fill vacancies created by resignations since the original formation of the delegation last spring.
