

COPY TO MR LOORZ --
AND MR CUTTER.

Aug. 6, 1936.

Dear Miss Morgan:

In addition to the \$25,000 a month allotted by Mr. Hearst for construction work at San Simeon and Wyntoon, you undoubtedly know that \$7,500 a month and about \$750 a week additional is being expended respectively for work that Mr. Loorz is directly supervising at San Simeon, and work that Mr. Stoltz is supervising at Wyntoon.

MR. HEARST WISHES TO KEEP THE TOTAL EXPENDITURE FOR ALL THIS WORK WITHIN THE \$32,500 A MONTH ALLOTTED TO YOU AS ABOVE.

He would like you to give it general supervision, deciding what is to go ahead and what is to be held in abeyance; of course your construction will take precedence.

I have explained this to Mr. Cutter. He says, and it seems proper, that a few weeks of the present arrangement will probably be necessary before cutting down.
