I assume that out of our limited Sunday circulation in your area you have seen a copy of the story I did on the "private war" on communism in your area.

However, a copy is enclosed.

I hope you find the treatment fair and in keeping with our "ground rules." I have sent a copy along to Jack Howard and will also send along the tape as soon as I have completed making a transcript.

Your clips will be returned shortly; I want to have a complete record of my source material available here in case of a "come back" attempt from any of those involved.

The reaction by Tolmach's nominal superiors here at Hamilton Air Force Base has been skitterish; they agreed he did wrong, but they don't think his remarks were any more than intemperate.

I've had no other reaction yet--other than indications through telephone calls and comment that the piece was rather widely read.

I want to thank you for your assistance, and for the consideration you showed me. Let me know, if you will, should the problem begin to bubble again, particularly if Huffaker is allowed to return and resume where he left off.
