ANDERSON: On the job working for you

Elected Mayor of Hawthorne at 27—youngest Mayor in the Nation—Glenn Anderson brings 25 years of responsible state and local government experience to the office of Lt. Governor.

The Lt. Governor is constitutionally charged with acting as President of the Senate and with assuming the duties and responsibilities of the Governor whenever the Governor shall leave the boundaries of California. He actively serves on 12 Boards and Commissions.

- presided over the California Senate a total of 276 days;
- an 88 percent record of active attendance serving as a Regent of the University of California and as a member of the Board of Trustees of the California State College system;

ANDERSON: The quiet man who gets things done

Without fanfare, but with steadfast courage, Lt. Governor Anderson has accomplished much for the people of California—a few accomplishments:

- On the STATE LANDS COMMISSION Anderson has fought for the maximum potential revenue from the State Tidelands oil pool by resisting a monopoly effort, and by insisting on competitive bidding—bringing to the people of California additionally tens of millions of dollars in revenue from oil and gas royalties.
- On the BOARD OF REGENTS Anderson has consistently fought for the Tuition Free concept of higher education and has become the State's foremost articulate champion of the renowned California Master Plan of Education. He has been a leader in the fight for higher pay for teachers; has improved academic standards through measures such as the Fisher Bill; diverted a higher percentage of the State's economic resources to public education needs.
- In the ASSEMBLY Anderson introduced the bill which abolished racial segregation in California's Public Schools in 1947; the bill providing aid to needy children; co-authored the Child Care Centers Bill.
- On the INTER-STATE COOPERATION COMMISSION Anderson initiated the proposal for the gigantic two-state park at Lake Tahoe, protecting the beauty of one of California's last remaining natural wonders; fought interests in order to preserve our beaches and coastlines.

Glenn Anderson, a native Californian, has served his Country in the Armed Forces in World War II, waiving deferment to enlist as a Private—discharged as Infantry Sergeant; has been a successful business man; in the field of government, has been a driving, hard working, responsible leader supported by millions of Californians who have elected and re-elected him to office; within the Democratic Party, has been an effective leader holding office as County Chairman and State Central Committee Chairman; has received 82 plaques, citations and honorary degrees conferred on him in recognition of his realistic and responsible leadership in education, industrial development and human rights.


ANDERSON: Those who know him best
