August 22 – 27: Monday – Thursday, 8 a.m. – 6 p.m., Fridays, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.; and Saturdays, 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.

August 29 – September 10 (first two weeks of classes): Monday – Thursday, 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.; Fridays, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.; and Saturdays, 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. **Exception:** closed Labor Day, Monday, September 5.
