- Students on academic probation who didn't see an advisor before first reg now have registration holds until they meet an advisor before 2<sup>nd</sup> reg.

Liaison Reports:

- ❑ Athletic Council (D. Girman): meeting today—talking about what to name the gym.
- ❑ Academic Advising (D. Girman): approved vote for ONE student, not all 3;
  - Language developed as recommendation for departments in addressing advising in RTP documents.
  - Undeclared seniors—does there need to be a change to advising policy? Recommend registration holds for such students.
- ❑ Scholarship Committee (M. Buckley): Still undecided about whether letters are necessary. E-mail vote is coming up. Some scholarships do require letters, but many don't consider the letters at all. Median GPA for recipients was 3.85.
- ❑ Fee Advisory (M. Buckley): With regard to leftover money from overenrollment, 2 clubs applied for funds and were approved. Eligibility applications being reviewed this week.
