### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, 52% of the population are women; and

WHEREAS, many inequities in laws, practice and conditions exist which adversely impact women; and

WHEREAS, the County of Ventura does not have a Commission whose sole purpose is to study changing roles and responsibilities of women, the impact of these changes on institutions and society; to promote means by which women will be more able to contribute to and participate in society; to act as an information center for the public and for government on the status of women in education, employment, business and other areas of concern; to act as a clearinghouse in providing technical assistance and advice to various agencies who are developing programs to meet the special needs of women; or to report findings and recommendations to the Board of Supervisors;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Ventura County Branch of the American Association of University Women hereby recommends establishment of a County of Ventura Commission on the Status of Women to provide the above designated services and to interact with the 20 other county commissions as well as the State of California Commission on the Status of Women.
