Enclosed is the plan with the two small symmetrical staircase towers and the reversed breakfast room, also a floor plan showing same idea fitted into the old exterior with the smaller staircase. This shortens the building and gives a more picturesque line while perhaps not so correct.

To me the layout with the breakfast room line at right angles to refectory is a very great improvement architecturally, however it may be treated in detail.

I will make all the openings so that they can be filled out in various ways as you may find something you especially want to place. A grill the size of the repeated arch looking into the court would be very effective.
