Dear Ms. Tolmach:

Thank you for your letter to Governor Brown expressing your concerns for the supervision of education programs at Camarillo and Napa State Hospitals. I have been asked to respond and explain what action has been taken to continue to provide quality education services to the children at Camarillo and Napa State Hospitals.

In reviewing situations at Camarillo and Napa, a decision was made to provide an additional Assistant Chief (Education) position which would enable the present person who has been in the position of Supervisor of Academic Instruction to remain within the Childrens' Program. Consequently the Childrens' Programs will continue to have educators supervising the teachers as well as an Assistant Chief of Education for the entire facility. The additional position, as well as the new position, should enable all children to receive equal services on a quality level as part of their treatment program.

If the children should at any time receive an education service which is not of a quality level, I will take action to see that the education service is improved. Thank you for your continued support of the education services for children in state hospitals.
