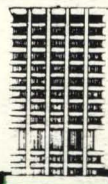
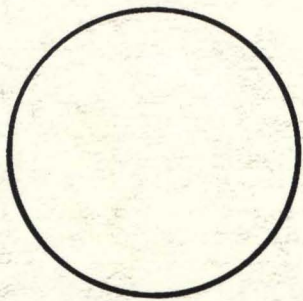

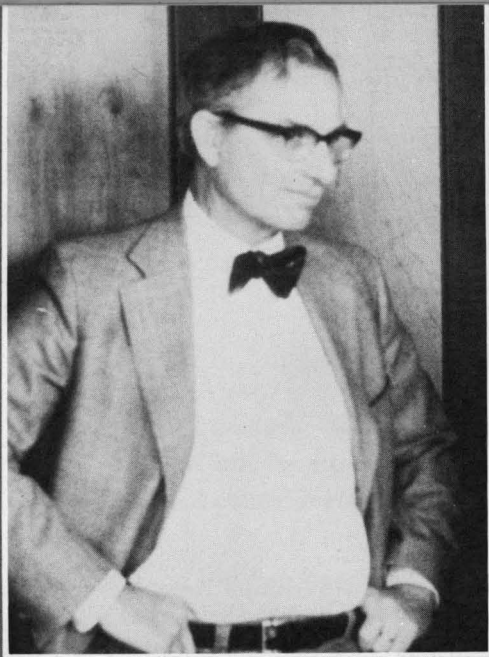

Graduation is a time of reflection. It is an opportunity to look back over past accomplishments and to look ahead toward future aspirations and goals.

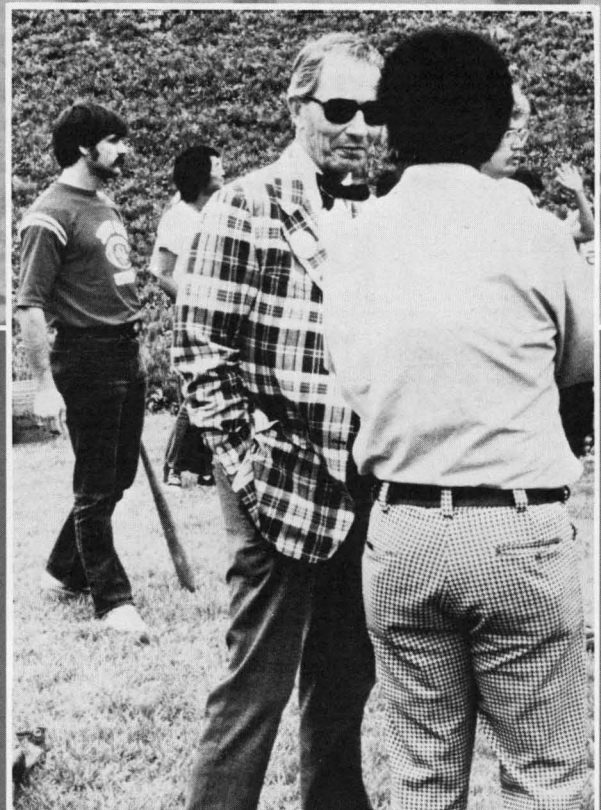

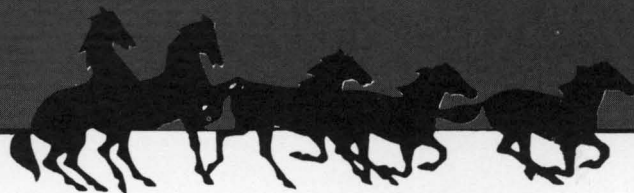

# Backers are optimistic about election

This fall students will vote on a tax to build a Student Union. Seen by many as a means to spark social life on campus, the proposal will eventually add seven dollars to current registration fees.

The plan, put together by the University Union Planning Committee (UUPC), calls for the addition of two levels to the cafeteria. The building is expected to house a recreation area, lounges and a service area, in addition to Associated Students (AS) and campus club offices. The Union is currently expected to be ready for use by September 1980, at a cost of \$2 million.

A 2/3 Yes vote is needed for passage.

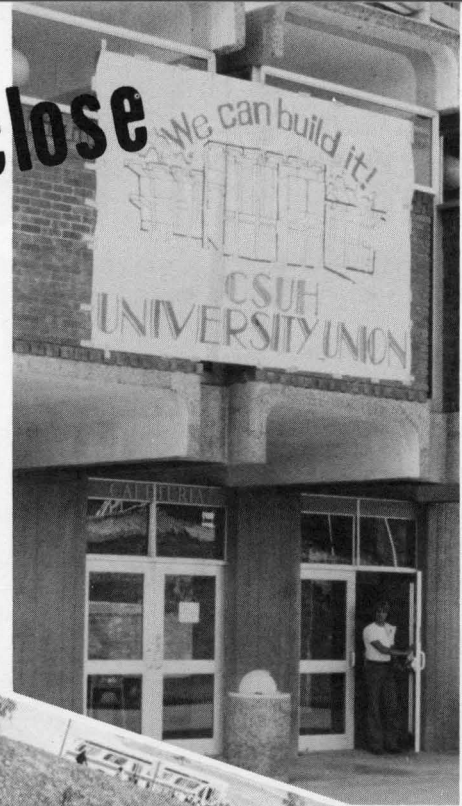
Cal State students will vote on Nov. 7, 8, 9 and 10 on whether to build a student union here. If passed by two-thirds of the voters, the proposal would add up to \$7 to registration fees per quarter.

The Cal State Hayward football team has not been as impressive as they were this past season. The reorganized Pioneers showed the ability and class of a team to be reckoned with in the Far West Conference in the following seasons. In this past season the Pioneers sported the record of 6-3-1, and gained the respect of so called power-house teams in the conference.

The team was led by its outstanding defense. Cal State gave up the fewest amount of points (136), and ended up No. 8 in the nation against the run.

Art (Biletnikoff) Bridgeman making an attempt for the ball. Bridgeman caught 19 passes for five Td's.



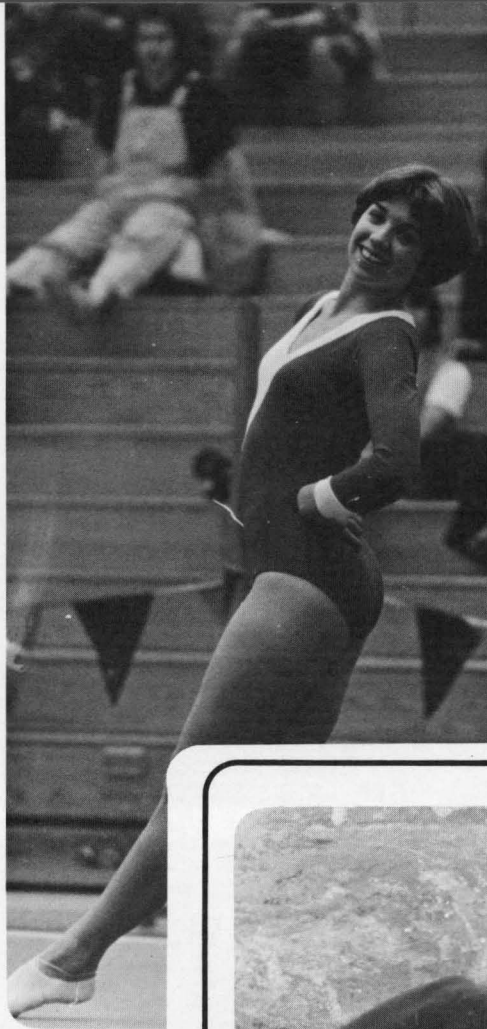
Jonathan Stagers, Cal State's head basketball coach, has finally found himself back into a familiar and most welcome situation. Coach Stagers and the Cal State Pioneers are winning games. After hard and long past seasons, the men's basketball team is now playing up to the potential of their performance that made them tri-champions of the Far Western Conference a year ago.

Apparently coach Stagers and his philosophy paid off. Stagers believes that the key to basketball is that a coach must ask himself whether he is coaching basketball or people. Stagers must have come up with the right answer because the team is playing great ball.

Some of the familiar names in the line up did not appear this season, at least not at the time of this article. Rodney Crump suffered a broken ankle early in the year, Darnell Flourney and Steve Manselle are ineligible because of academic standings. Without these performers the team was weakened, but the Pioneers showed tremendous ability to take time with a new system of playing and develop it into a winner.

Behind Stagers the team has found a pride, a sense of positive thinking and the attitude of working for a goal. Instilled with their natural abilities and the coaching of Stagers, the team has developed into a fine fundamental winning system.

# Football team clinches winning season

The Cal State football team clinched their first winning season since 1971 with a 27-14 Far Western Conference victory over Sacramento State Saturday night.

With the win, their first in conference play, the Pioneers are now 5-2-1 overall with two games

hands of strong safety Marvin Marks, who ran 30 yards for the score. The extra point by Doug Saucedo made it 7-0, Cal State.

Sacramento State turned the ball over again on their next possession when Pioneer linebacker Rod Beaver recovered a bad pitch fumble at the Hornet's 14 yard line.

With little time remaining in the first half, Sacramento State got on the board with a touchdown to cut the Pioneer lead to 17-7 at intermission.

In the fourth quarter, Pioneer running back Rick Pierleoni scored from five yards out to extend the Pioneer lead with the extra point to 24-7. The versatile

fourth quarter to a 20 point lead.

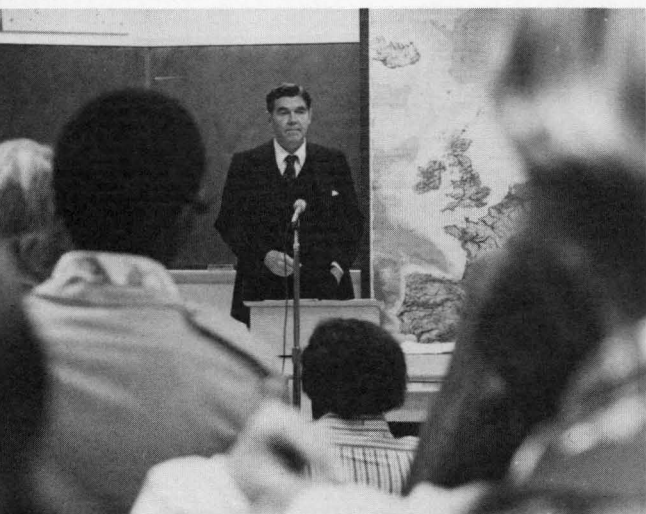
The scoring ended with a 85 yard kickoff by Ralph Clark returning it 85 yards down.
