The work earnings of all employees within the family group were recorded by the Personal Records Section. This record was maintained and supervised by Arthur H. Peters, Administrative Timekeeper. From these records, this office was able to furnish at any time a total earnings report of any individual or a family group who had been employed at one time or another within the Center. Mr. Peters also kept the time of all administrative employees, including the preparation and submission of time reports. Records of total amount of free scripts issued to an individual or family group were also kept.

The timekeeping for the evacuees was supervised by Yone Satoda, who was recognized as a very capable, qualified person. Yone Satoda had under his supervision 34 timekeepers and timecheckers. Rene Miyake was assistant to Satoda and his duties were auditing of all time reports and payrolls of individual time records.

Up to the time of writing, an expenditure of approximately

\$60,000 has been accounted for by the timekeeping section. Approximately 7,000 individual checks have been issued. The timekeeping section has been divided into five sub-sections known as the Mess and Lodging, Works Division, Service Division, Administrative offices, Supply, Police and Mess Warehouse. The supervising timekeepers were held responsible for the supervision of their timecheckers within their respective divisions. They were also required to make spot checks against the timekeepers to determine that each timekeeper was carrying out the duties required. Ted Inahara held dual responsibilities as he supervised preparation of daily meal count report, the weekly report, report of all employees working by sections, and supervision of Mess Hall timekeepers. A great deal of credit is due to the Timekeeping section for the accurate and efficient manner in which they have carried out their duties. Kiku Nakamichi and Suniko Tsuji were responsible for general office routine work.
