All Americans -- Democrats, Republicans and Independents -- who support President Johnson's program have been invited to appoint themselves a Committee of One and to join other citizens in Community Operation Support Committees.

As Committees of One and in Community Committees, citizens are being asked by Democratic National Committee Chairman John M. Bailey and Vice Chairman Margaret Price "to let their voices be heard for LBJ for the USA".

"The story of our nation's prosperity, its strength and stability, and the programs such as the Poverty Program, which show the compassion of the nation for those who need help is a dramatic story which affects every American", Chairman Bailey said. "It is a positive story which deserves to be told widely and effectively".

"Operation Support programs in every state will assist individuals and groups which support President Johnson on key issues in the President's record of achievement and plans for future progress," Mrs. Price said.

Operation Support Co-Chairmen from each of the fifty states are being appointed, and a concerted effort is underway to increase understanding of the vital issues in this campaign in order to insure the election of President Johnson in November. Operation Support will also work for the election of all Democratic candidates, who share President Johnson's position on such important issues as Civil Rights, Poverty, Health Care for the Aged through Social Security, and Foreign Policy.

Headquarters for the program is fully staffed and prepared to provide complete information on all key issues by means of information kits, pamphlets, and other materials. Among the functions planned expressly for this program are educator discussion groups, and a weekly newsletter mailed from Headquarters to keep the states informed of what action is being taken in their neighboring states. Operation Support will also make full use of the Speakers Bureau at the National Committee and plans to initiate speakers bureaus in the states.
