STUDENT PUBLICATIONS

Membership in the Associated Students entitles the holder to copies of publications financed by the Associated Students fee. *The Daily Collegian* is the Associated Students news publication. The student literary magazine, *Backwash*, is available to students at a nominal charge.

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The Alumni Association seeks to advance the welfare of the university and the welfare of its graduates, former students, and friends. The self-directed group serves as a liaison with the university, alumni, and the community. The Board of Directors, through the Alumni Office and its Director, sponsors numerous activities during the year: provides scholarship assistance to students; presents awards to outstanding students and alumni at graduation ceremonies; provides a Senior Yearbook program; is active in Vintage Days and Homecoming; puts on the Annual Barbeque; and supports the development of the university. Membership is open to graduates, any student who has attended one or more semesters at CSUF, and friends of the university. Annual dues are \$10; Life Memberships are \$150.

The CSUF Trust Council is a charitable organization which receives contributions from alumni and friends of the university. The Trust Council oversees the investment of all contributions and funds which are then used to support scholarships, programs of the Association, and to promote the welfare of the university.
