

## CSUCI Course Modality Overview

CSUCI offers courses across eleven categories, which fall into three modalities: online, blended or hybrid, and in person. Under these three modality definitions, courses are identified in the following ways:

**Online courses include:** asynchronous instructional course section can be offered anywhere (no campus meetings) – AB386; synchronous instructional course section can be offered anywhere (no campus meetings) – AB386; asynchronous instructional course section (orientation, mid-term, final campus meetings allowed) – federal Distance Education; synchronous instructional course section (orientation, mid-term, final campus meetings allowed) – federal Distance Education; asynchronous instructional course section can be offered anywhere (no campus meetings) with synchronous instructional course section can be offered anywhere (no campus meetings) - AB386 – aka Hybrid (**NEW beginning Summer 2015**); and asynchronous instructional course section (orientation, mid-term, final campus meetings allowed) with synchronous instructional course section (orientation, mid-term, final campus meetings allowed) – federal Distance Education - aka Hybrid (**NEW beginning Summer 2015**).

**Note:** synchronous online supervision (**Deprecated beginning Summer 2015**) and synchronous online supervision (**Deprecated beginning Summer 2015**) are included above.

**Blended courses include:** asynchronous instructional course section segment with face-to-face course section segment (regular face-to-face meetings from every day to four or more times in the term) – aka Hybrid, list the course section and record the course credit units in online; and synchronous instructional course section segment with face-to-face course section segment (regular face-to-face meetings from every day to four or more times in the term) – aka Hybrid, list the course section and record the course credit units in online.

**In person courses include:** face-to-face.

## SUMMARY

As of October 2023, there were 1,671 classes listed in the [university catalog](#). Of these, 88% (n=1,467) have been offered face to face since Fall 2006, 63% (n=1,052) have been offered online since Fall 2015, and approximately 17% (n=284) have been offered in a blended format since Fall 2015.
