CHANCO CHANCO CHANCO CAROLL by RICHARD CARROLL

Chango Carmona was the King for fifty-seven glorious days. He was the "class" of Mex ico, at the pinnacle of his profession. There was none better in his classification and, as always, he was smiling, eternally smiling. fifty-seven days his smile was broader than usual because he was now enjoying paradise after ten years of hard labor and a lifetime of struggling and scratching for existence. The situation was eloquently exquisite. For fifty-seven days he was the World Boxing Council lightweight champion of the world. It was paradise gained.

It wasn't a dream come true for Chango. It had always been reality for living was reality. He learned early in life that things didn't just happen — you had to make them happen. Chango knew that luck was something you created by your deeds, that one

made his own luck.

Erubey Guillen Chapin, known in the boxing world as Chango Carmona, was raised in La Posa, Mexico, a tiny oceanside village near Acapulco. When Chango was two, his farm worker-field laborer father died, leaving six cows to Chango, his brother, and their mother. The two boys moved in with their grandmather who lived in a small shack that had neither running water nor electricity, but was kept immaculately clean. Chango grew up observing that within his natural environment moved people grossly different than him. They were called tourists and they possessed something he lacked — pesos. He vowed that somehow he would change this. If they had pesos then he would have pesos. It was as simple as that. His assets were a quick mind and great athletic ability that

came to him as easily as the gaudy, watered Coco-Locos came to the tourists.

In order to keep food on the table he went to work when he was old enough to walk. He cared fastidiously for his six cows, and delivered the milk they produced. He did not use the beach for sunbathing or body-surfing as the tourists and flashy jet-setters did, but as a way of adding to the family income. During the day he fished in the surf, and at dusk followed the tracks of sea turtles, gathering their eggs to sell in town for two pesos each. Each day he mounted his burro and made a trip into nearby forests to collect firewood, also converted into pesos in La Posa.

He became an excellent horseman and broke the wild horses sometimes captured in the surrounding Sierra Madre Mountains. By necessity he become a skilled marksman, hunting rabbit with bow and arrow and iguana with rocks. Wherever there was money to be made by wit and skill, Carmona made it, utilizing the natural resources of the Acapulco area, taking from the land

what it offered.

His agility in climbing coconut palms gained him the name Chango, which means monkey in Spanish. He would pluck and shake down the fruit and of course haul it into town. He maintained his strength by often eating iguana and rattlesnake, which he roasted over an open fire. He loved their delicate flavors, iguana tasting far better than chicken, and rattlesnake a definite delicacy.

All this in the shadow of Aca-

pulco, only a short way down the beach, where half-naked women swam in beautifully tiled pools with underwater bar stools and perfumed water flowing in the johns. Other affluent people who lived on the hill soaked in sunken baths, sipping cocktails, looking out at the gorgeous bay with its array of yachts from all parts of world. All-night parties stretched into days and enough food was wasted to feed Chango and his family for a week. Down below on the streets, tourists rode about town in horsedrawn carriages and out on the bay took glass-bottomed-boat trips. They played golf at Pierra Marques, tennis at Villa Vera, practiced scuba diving below the water and parachute flying above it. And best of all, they watched the clavadistas, the Cliff Divers, who dove from La Punta, the small ledge above La Quebrada, 136 feet down a sheer wall into the narrow gorge where surging surf is only twelve feet deep.

When Chango was ten years old, he began going to kindergarten, and diving. He realized that the Cliff Divers were famous. made good money, were respected and were also fine athletes. Why shouldn't he try it? Maybe he would become a diver. He knew that if they could do it he certainly could. As he did with anything he tried, he developed diving skills quickly. Chango and his buddies challenged one another to higher and higher lives, and finally he dived from a point halfway up the cliff, approximately 68

feet.

When he was 15, his church in La Posa promoted boxing benefits for a remodeling-building fund. Winners received a kiss from a beautiful young senorita, and

some assurance from the priest. Since Chango's love life at that time was a little flat — in fact, it hadn't even begun — he earned a few kisses and eased his way into boxing. He made his last dive from the famous cliffs when he was 18 years old, the same year

that he seriously started his fighting career and finished grammar school. He never became a part of the divers' union or the junior training program, but he still loves to dive and has his own favorite diving spot when in Acapulco.

In ten years time he became a fine fighter and developed a definite style, piling up an impressive 41 wins, 39 by knockouts, and 8 defeats. Most of his losses came early in his career and were revenged. Chango knew that he could work his way up in life because he always had great confidence in himseld and in his God. He never doubted that he could accomplish what he set out to do. whether it was hitting an iguana in the head with a rock or stalking rabbit with homemade bow and arrow. It was all necessity, not whim. (to be continued next issue)



BIG BROTHERS - BIG SISTERS OF SANTA CLARA COUNTY

WHO ARE WE? Big Brothers and Big Sisters of Santa Clara County is a social service agency with offices located in San Jose (180 East Gish Road) and in Sunnyvale (1080-B East Duane Avenue). The focus of our work is helping children in need of adult volunteers who are matched with a child on a long term, oneto-one basis.

WHEN DID WE START? Big Brothers of Santa Clara County, a California non-profit corporation, was formed and chartered in 1971. Bay Area Big Sisters was formed and incorporated in 1967, with a chapter located in Santa Clara County. Both groups operated independently until August, 1977, at which time the

Board of Directors of Big Brothers vovted to join operations with Big Sisters, thereby forming Big Brothers and Big Sisters of Santa Clara County. The agency is a full member of the Big Brothers and Big Sisters of America, the national organization, which dates back to 1903.

WHO RUNS IT? We have a 30-plus member Board of Diwhich consists of inrectors terested citizens including Business, Civic, and Labor leaders. The Agency has a staff of 17 (13 at the San Jose office, 4 at the Sunnyvale office).

HOW BIG ARE WE? We serve the entire County of Santa Clara. In total we have over 150 Brother/Little Brother matches and over 100 Big Sister/ Little Sister matches. There is cur- 23



rently more than 300 boys and girls on the Agency waiting list. This means that some children must wait more than a year to be "matched."

WHERE DO WE GET OUR LITTLE BROTHERS AND SISTERS? Many times it is the parent who calls the Agency to request a Big Brother or Big Sister. Children are also referred by social workers, public health nurses, school counselors, psychologists, and juvenile probation officers.

WHERE DO WE GET OUR BIG BROTHERS AND SISTERS? We rely heavily on Public Service Radio, Television, and Newspaper advertisements and coverage. Through the local media the Big Brother/Big Sister message reaches throughout the County.

HOW DO THE VOLUNTEERS BECOME BIG BROTHERS AND BIG SISTERS? First, they must attend an orientation meeting where they are given an accurate picture of what the program is about, what to expect and what not to expect. Second, they are given at least two separate interviews by trained social workers. Third, after being accepted in

to the program, he/she is presented with a few Little Brother's/Little Sister's according to personality, preferences and interests. The volunteer picks the child that appeals most to him/her.


