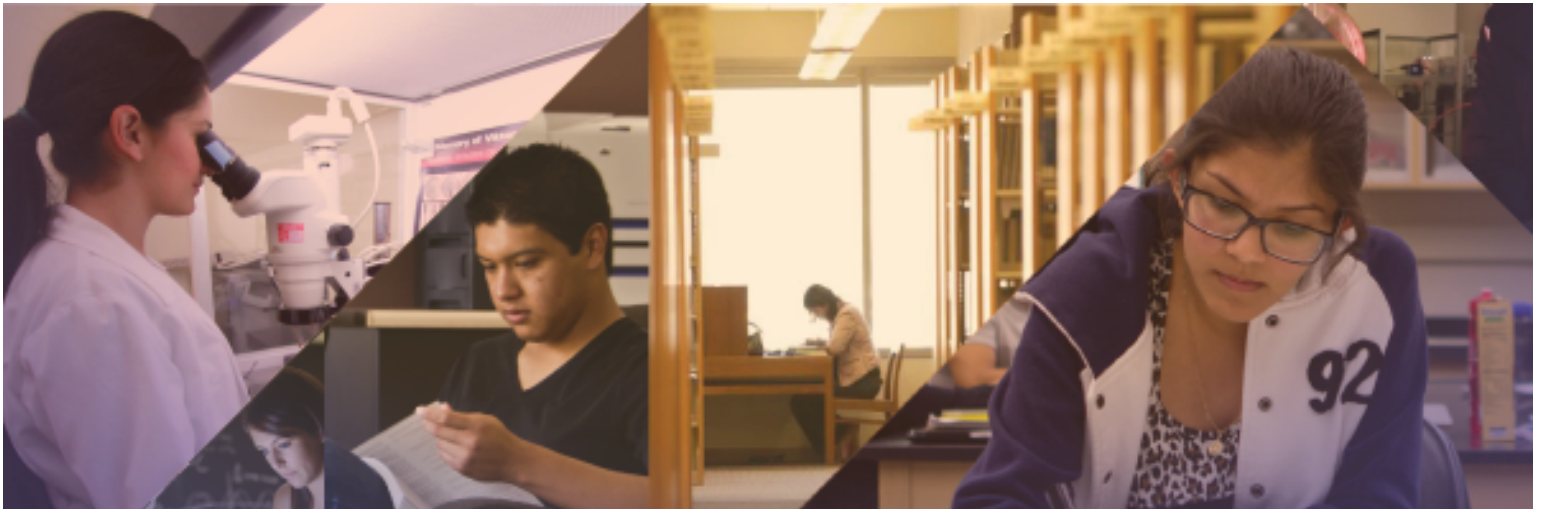




CSUSM LIBRARY AWARD for Undergraduate Research, Scholarship & Creative Activity

and/or staff member at CSUSM during
the following terms: Summer 2016, Fall
2016, or Spring 2017

Agree to contribute to a display of their
research during the year following
receipt of the prize

Agree to have their submissions
included in the CSUSM Institutional
