## About the Award

This award, now in its second year, recognizes CSUSM undergraduate students who demonstrate sophistication and originality in research projects and creative works, and reflection upon the research/creation process.

Up to 6 prizes will be awarded in 3 categories:
Creative Works
Empirical Research
Interpretive Analysis

Winners receive a **\$600 cash prize** & public recognition of their excellent work.

## Eligibility

Applicants must:

Be enrolled as a undergraduate student at the time of project completion

Have completed the research project under the guidance of a CSUSM faculty and/or staff member at CSUSM during the following terms: Summer 2016, Fall 2016, or Spring 2017

Agree to contribute to a display of their research during the year following receipt of the prize

Agree to have their submissions included in the CSUSM Institutional Repository. The applicants will retain copyright.
