As was planned during the March 13th field meeting called by Oxnard Mayor Tom Holden, a small group will meet immediately prior to the Ormond Beach Task Force meeting this week on Thursday, starting at 1145 for about an hour. (Same room as OBTF) To keep the meeting small and productive with lunch available to all (compliments of Mayor Holden), the attendance is targeted to the 11 recipients to this email message.

The project is to plan and eventually build as soon as possible an Observation Platform or Short Tower - with interpretive panels-- at the Arnold Road entrance to Ormond Beach project area. Of course, this is not a Visitor Center but more of relatively quick way to improve public awareness and appreciation of the Ormond Beach wetlands via an Observation Platform that already has been discussed with positive reaction during earlier meetings of Ormond Beach Task Force.

Attached is a picture collage to inspire more thought about the platform or tower designs. This was prepared when the project idea originated. It prints best on tabloid (11x17 inch) paper.

Here are some items to start the discussion Thursday at 1145:

1. Project Scope (platform / tower size and place)
2. Design Contest approach by local colleges, universities, boutique firms
3. Arnold Road barricade converted into a real gate
4. Suggestion of Portable Outhouses established and maintained at Arnold Road
5. Schedule and Funding
