Closing the loops

GE Program Review

- GE Committee discusses the need for a GE Program Review (Fall 04)
- GE Committee drafts a GE Program Review Policy (Spr 05)
- GE Program Review Policy passed by the Academic Senate (Spr 05)
- GE Committee conducts its first program review on Area B (Spr 06)
- GE Committee disseminates its findings to Area B Faculty, Program Chairs, and Academic Affairs Administrators (Sum 06)
- Provost and program chairs reinforce need to place SLOs on all syllabi (Fall 06)
- Recommendation that GE Courses an SLOs need to be better identified on syllabi. The draft of the Faculty Affairs Sylla Policy includes a requirement for GE SLOs. (Fall 06)
- Courses not taught are marked for decertification (Fall 06)
- Discussion begins on how to improve the GE Program Review process (Fall 06)



- GE Assessment Task Force drafts the GE Assessment Plan (Fall 05)
- Faculty (from different disciplines) come together to map GE Criteria for Area B to course specific Student Leaning Outcomes
- GE Assessment examines MAPPS data and discusses potential uses (Spr 06)
- CIS hosts the pilot assessment to assess the GE Student Learning Outcome on Interdisciplinarity (Jan 07)
- Group meets to discuss the results of the pilot assessment and crafts a plan to disseminate results to faculty (Spr 07)
- Group meets to develop an assessment tool for the GE Outcomes on Information Literacy (Spr 07)
