- 3. Continuing Professional Training Plan (CPT). This plan is completed on an annual basis following the probationary period. Total hours for this plan = 60 minimum**
 - a. EMT recertification
 - b. CPR & First Aid recertification (for non EMT) - minimum 10 hours
 - c. New Laws and Legal Updates – minimum 4 hours
 - d. Officer Survival topics – minimum 8 hours
 - e. New concepts, current procedures, technology – minimum 8 hours
 - f. Discretionary decision making (practical scenarios) – minimum 16 hours
 - g. Use of Force policy – minimum 2 hours
 - h. Demonstrate proficiency with all lethal and less-lethal weapons authorized by the department – minimum 8 hours
 - i. Ethics – minimum 4 hours
- 4. Perishable Skills Training Plan (PST). This plan is completed on an annual basis following the probationary period. Total hours for this plan = 20 minimum**
 - a. Arrest & Control – minimum 4 hours
 - b. Driver Training/Awareness or Driving Simulator – minimum 4 hours
 - c. Tactical Firearms or Force Options Simulator – minimum 4 hours
 - d. Tactical communications – minimum 2 hours
 - e. Interpersonal communications – minimum 2 hours
