






## LETTERS to the EDITOR

THE QUIET
MEXICAN AMERICAN - SILENCED

"Our failures, not our successes, will be remembered-----

Mr. Diaz, I congratulate you for your ardent interest in public affairs and for the way you write as a proud Mexican-American. You have expressed this in your articles which have appeared in EL EXCENTRICO magazine.

I understand that we Mexican Americans are stereotyped as a group of people who do not necessarily unite in society or in government affairs, but who remain, in most together in ghettos. Based on this image, adjectives such as apathetic, ignorant, and unconcerned are used as general terms to describe the Mexican-American.

Well, Mr. Diaz, I am concerned. I am concerned about or image and our cultural heritage and all that is reflected in our literature. Therefore, as a concerned Mexican-American, it is my opinion that the article published in the Excentrico January 30, 1965, titled "True Unity Among Our Public Gatherings" was written with good intentions. You intended to communicate to the reader the basic concepts of unity and the importance of unity to suppress, and in due time to eradicate the problems involved with the Mexican American.

Analyzing your title one would surmise that the topic of unity would be well described in detail. However, after evaluating your article, I found it very contradictory, incoherent, ambiguous and lacking in information supporting your thesis on unity.

The introduction leads the reader aimlessly into a tempest of unrelated phrases. An example of the confusion is depicted in an excerpt from your article:

\*Even though they (who are they) were not to be found in our early American doctrines, the principle behind their thinking (who is thinking) was the same: United we stand divided we fall. (Should read: United we stand, divided we fall). And my fel-

low readers it was not many years ago that our Mexican comrades had a strong government, and proudest military forces in the world. Tho something was missing, "Unity" and our downfall came to pass, (Who had the downfall -- The Mexican government or the United States?) but let it be known, we no longer walk about blindfolded and we the youth with leadership qualities intend to reconstruct our people by using unity as our prime weapon. (Who are "we the youth" supposed to reconstruct? This is perplexing since you have mentioned the Mexican government and you have referred to our American forefathers).

Continuing the evaluation of your article, we are confronted by the praise and recognition you have given the Rainbow Ballroom as a place to serve and entertain the public. This seems to be a good topic to expound upon in a separate article - it certainly does not relate to your main topic of unity.

Although I am glad to know that Mr. Davilla is a good citizen, did you really want to inform us of the respect you get from all those who know Mr. Davilla, or is it the respect people have for Mr. Davilla: observe, "Frank is a respectable citizen, and a parent of three wonderful individuals and I (A. D. Diaz?) am sure respected by all who know him."

\*NOTE: Words in parenthesis are my comments.

There are other items of equal importance within your article which should be pointed out, however, I do not wish to take up so much of your time discussing your solecisms.

As a writer you are aware that our literature is a source of communication. We are communicating to the people exactly what we know and what we know is what we write. Therefore, our image in literature is reflected to the public.

I would suggest to the editor of this magazine that if the image which has been portrayed by Mr. Diaz's articles continue, then he should sign his articles the "Anonymous Mexican-American." This way we will not know who the villian is, better yet - don't sign Mexican-American.
