

CONTRACT LET FOR CMA JOB

Contracts totaling \$401,036 for construction of a new engineering building at the California Maritime Academy were awarded today in Sacramento by the State Department of Public Works.

The \$266,696 contract for general work went to S. J. Amoroso Construction Co. of San Francisco.

Other contracts included heating work, \$36,800 to Bell Products, Inc., Napa; plumbing work, \$18,763 to Harold Beasley Plumbing, Vallejo, and electrical, \$78,777 to Collins Electrical Co., Inc., Stockton.

Completion of the one-story building is set in August, 1961.

It will provide a modern machine shop, electronics shop, electrical shop, class rooms and office space. A maritime diesel engine shop also will be included.
