

- ~ Charlie motioned that the minutes of Wednesday, March 7, 2007 be approved; Ryan seconded the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved 9-Yes/0-No.
- ~ **CCR 03/07-03 LDR 210 Foundations of Leadership.**

Chair Questionnaire attached. The committee would like Science & Mathematics to supply that form. Lui motioned that this CCR be tabled until Friday, April 13; Charlie seconded the motion. The vote was 8-Yes/0-No/1-Abstention.
