

Dear Salzie

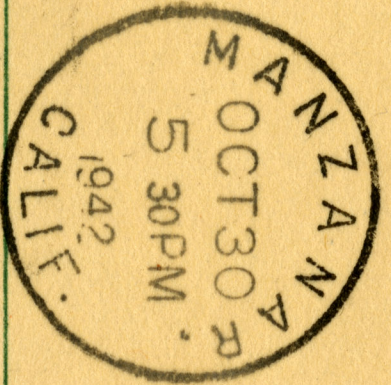
