AGREEMENT FOR CAMARILLO AIRPORT

The Ventura County Board of Supervisors has instructed this office to respond to the proposed agreement where the request was "approve or reject by March 29, 1971."

The Board on March 23 made the decision that the provisions of the proposed agreement were not acceptable to the County. This decision was made reluctantly, since any operational program is dependent upon coordination and cooperation with the Cities of Camarillo and Oxnard.

The Board is committed to operating the facility within the restrictions that were defined by the Environmental Impact Study and the input of Wyle Laboratories. There is also a commitment on the part of the Board to seek with you and the Council of the City of Camarillo, an agreement with the general provisions that were developed through cooperative efforts in January of 1971.

The Board and staff are most anxious to pursue the cooperative plan for operation of the Camarillo Airport, realizing the commitment of all elected officials to protect the environment of the area, and to act in unison on matters of general public interest.
