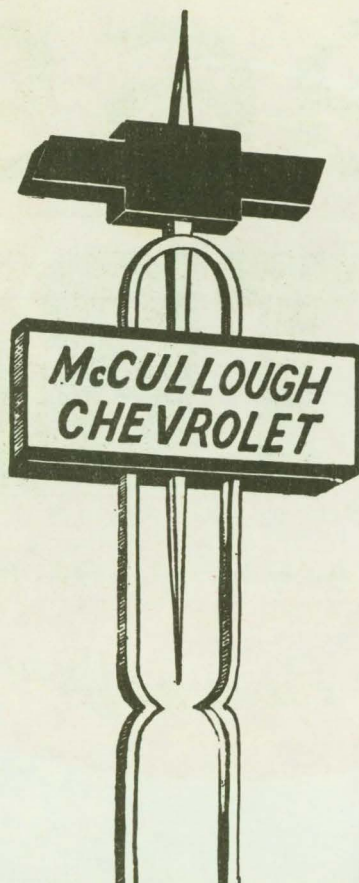

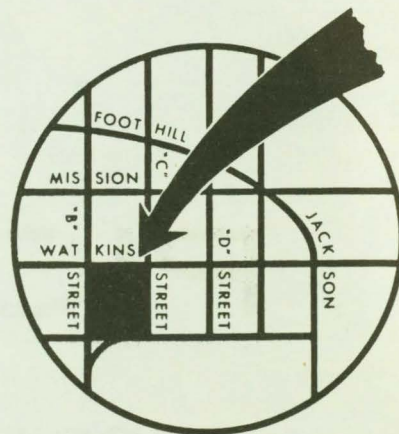

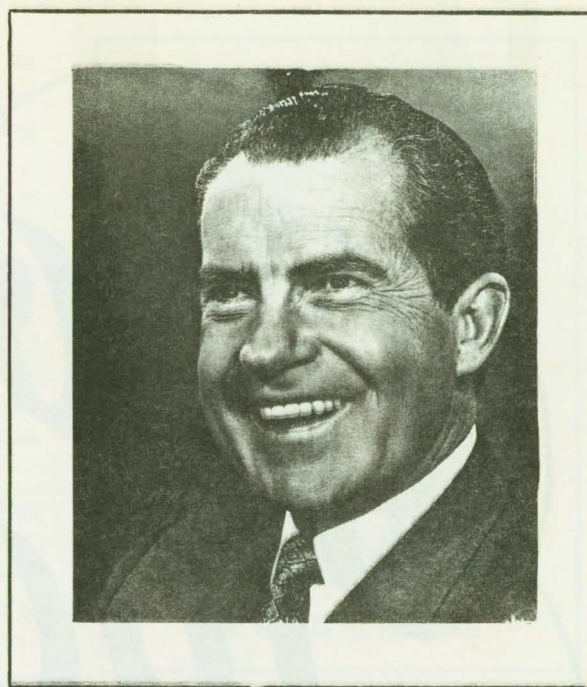

COLLEGE FOOTBALL'S CENTENNIAL

One hundred years ago the first intercollegiate football game was played in the United States. Since that November day when students from Princeton and Rutgers began it all, the game has thrilled generations of Americans as players and spectators.

My congratulations go to intercollegiate football--and to all those who play the game, whether it be on a make-shift field or in the great stadiums--on its one hundredth birthday. It is a game which not only has thrilled generations of Americans but has also helped to develop qualities of sportsmanship and competitiveness in those generations.

Dr. Ellis E. McCune, who served as interim president for the past two years, has been appointed permanent president.

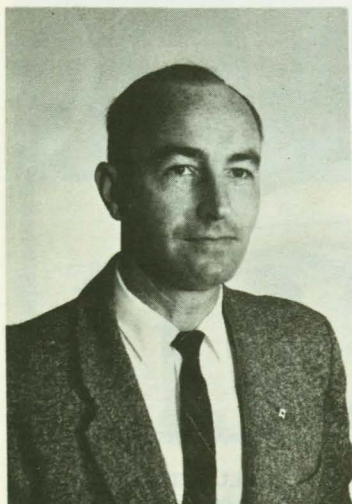
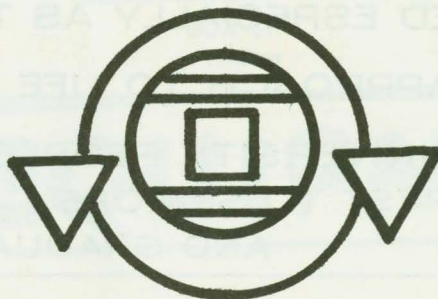

The physical plant is growing, too as work continues on a \$11 million Administration-Library complex.

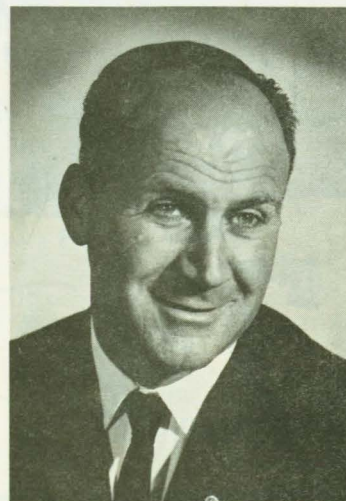
Cal State Hayward faculty increased by 75 full-time professors to a total of nearly 600. The college is building to a master plan enrollment of 22,500 students by 1978.



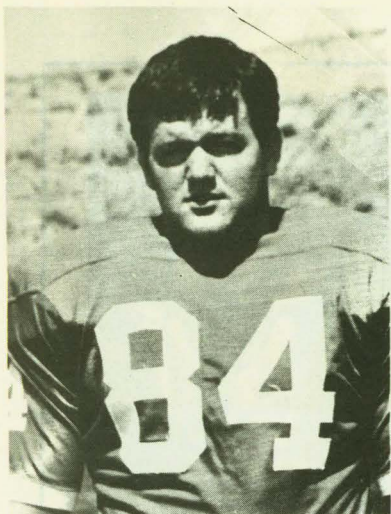

The Community – Cal State Stadium Seating Project

has reached its goal of raising \$135,000 for the installation of 8,000 permanent seats and the related site development and landscaping for the first phase of the stadium project.

With addition of the permanent seats on the east side, it gives Cal State the largest football stadium in the Far Western Conference with a spectator seating capacity of 8,000.

The seating portion of the project is complete, but the related site development and landscaping are not yet installed. The entrance area to the stadium complex (pictured above), containing the ticket booths, entrance gates, landscaping and donor memorial, are presently being completed. Site development in the stadium, including walkways and guard rails, is scheduled for completion this season.

The stadium project was made possible only through the generous participation of citizens and companies in the area. The College and all the individuals and organizations associated with the Community – Cal State Stadium Seating Drive are indebted to those who have made this project possible. A dedication for the stadium project is scheduled for October 18 of this year, and all donors will be honored at that time.
