
Subject: Ormond Beach Power Plant

The Aviation Advisory Committee at their October 21 meeting went on record as recommending to the Board of Supervisors that the Board take whatever steps within its power to restrict the height of the proposed Ormond Beach electrical power generating plant.

It has been brought to the attention of the Committee that it is proposed by Southern California Edison Company that a 300 ft. high smokestack will be erected at the forementioned plant. It is the opinion of the Aviation Advisory Committee that such a stack will constitute a definite hazard to aircraft operating on the Oxnard plains area and that the basic reason for the height of the stack is to allow the use of smog-generating fuel oils.

It was further recommended that the Board direct the County Counsel's Office to investigate what action the Board can take to reduce the height of this structure to within a reasonable height as set forth in the FAA criteria for air navigation obstructions.
