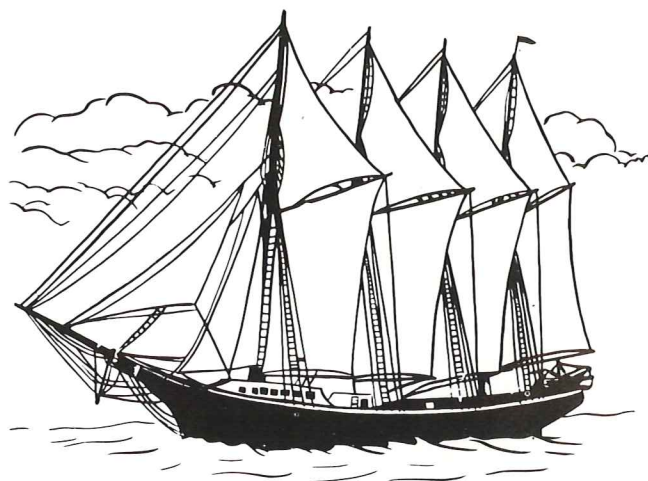
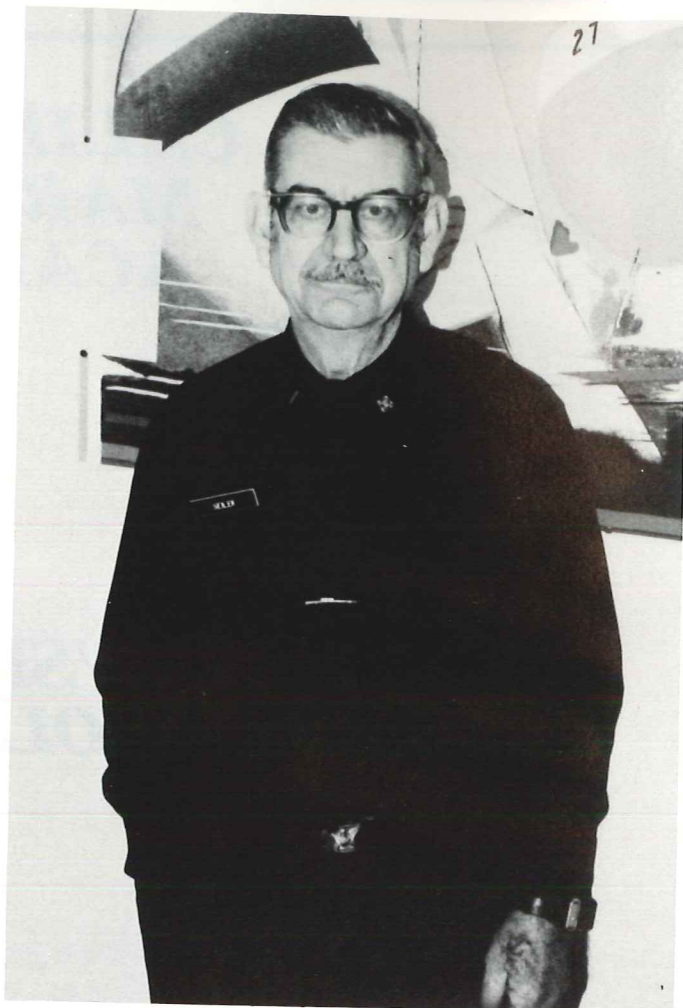
P.M. Seiler retired from the California Maritime Academy after a seagoing career that spanned half a century.

In addition to watch standing and ships maintenance the third class also attend classes in communications, rules of the road and seamanship which are taught by the first class.



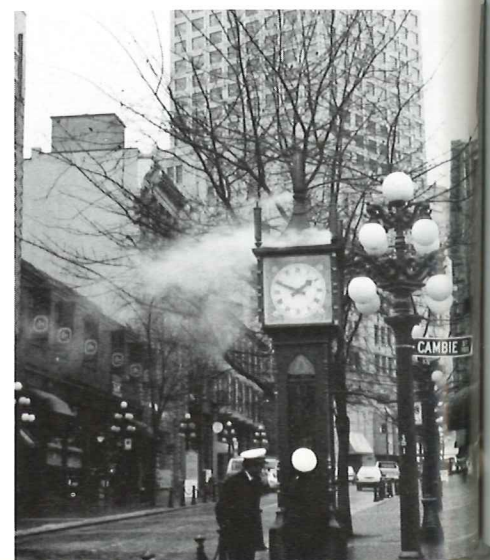

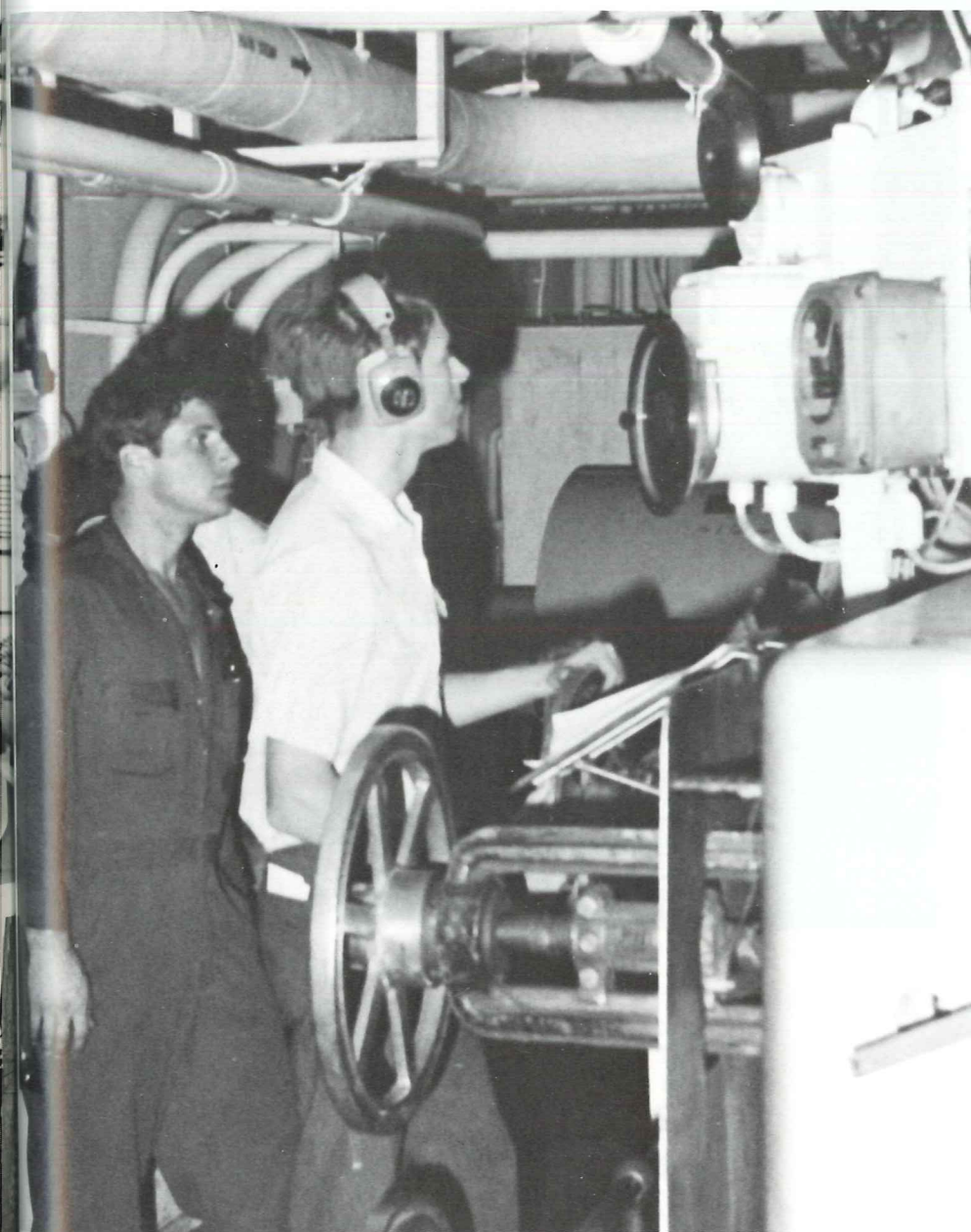


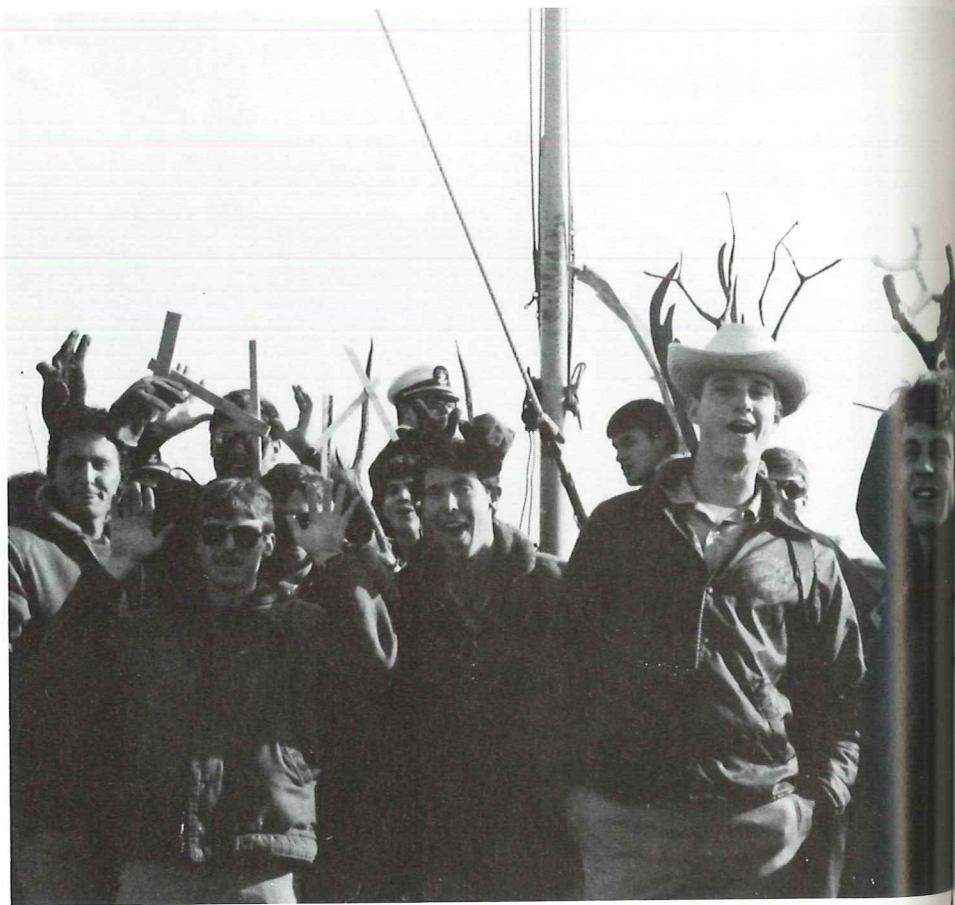
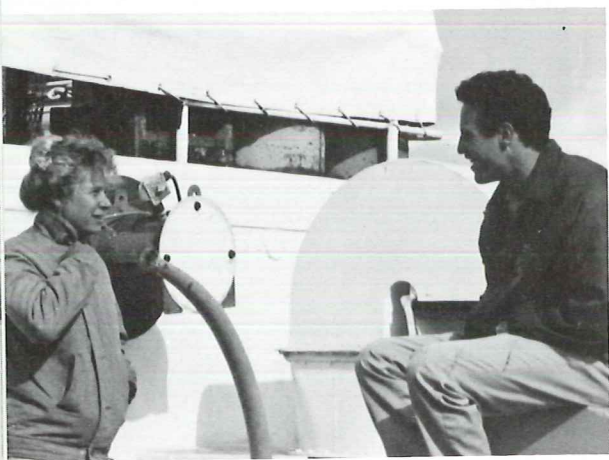


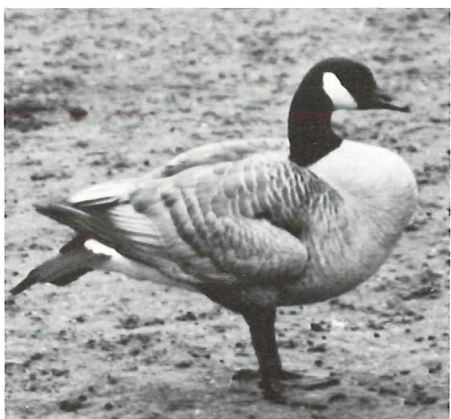
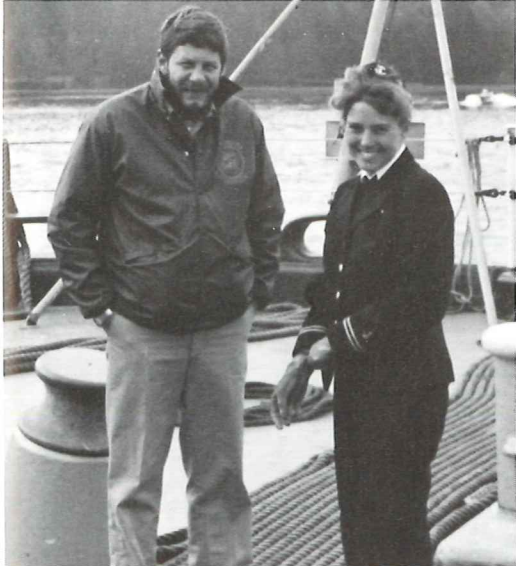
TSGB HAS SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE

DEATH OF A FRIEND

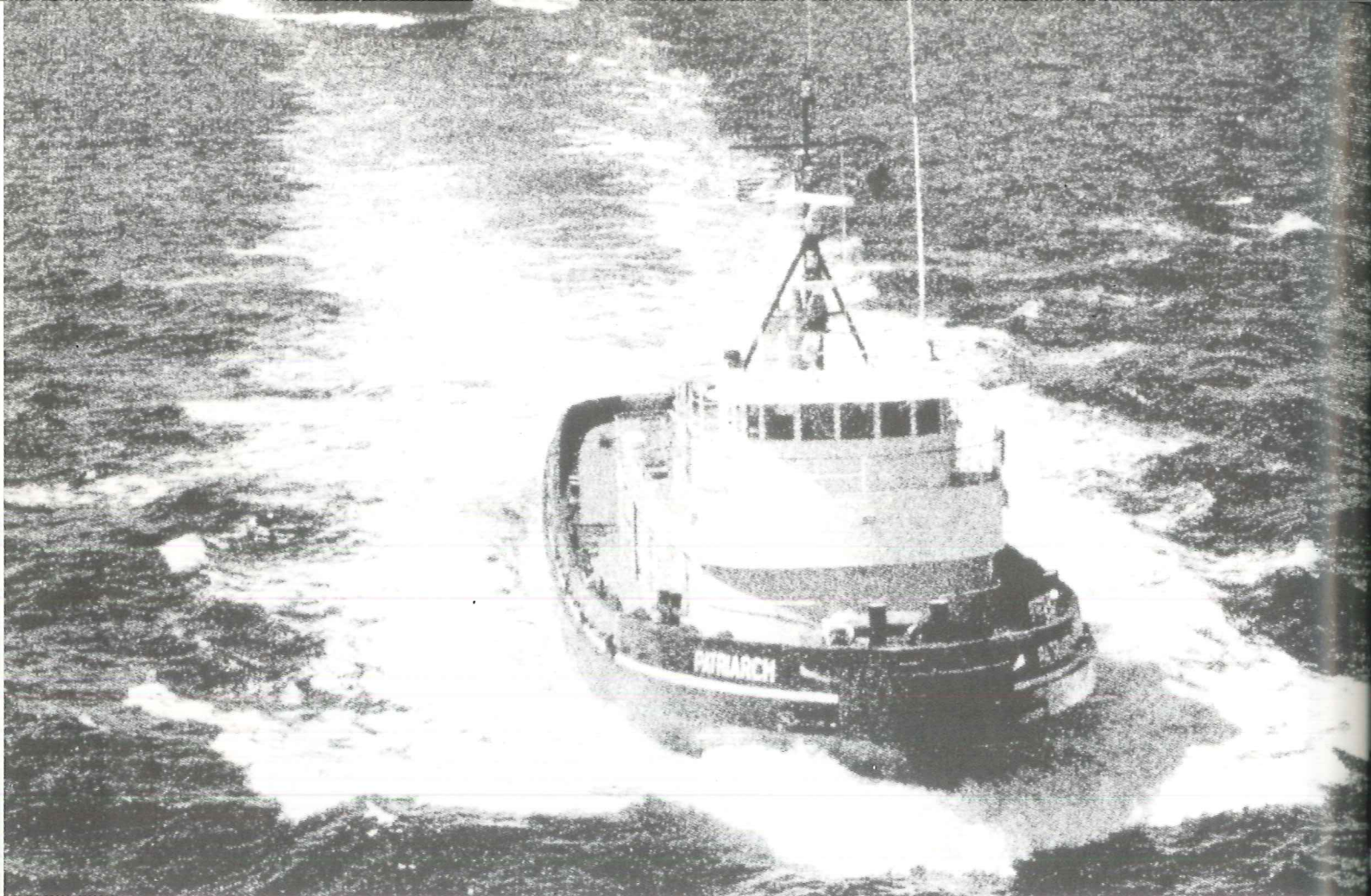

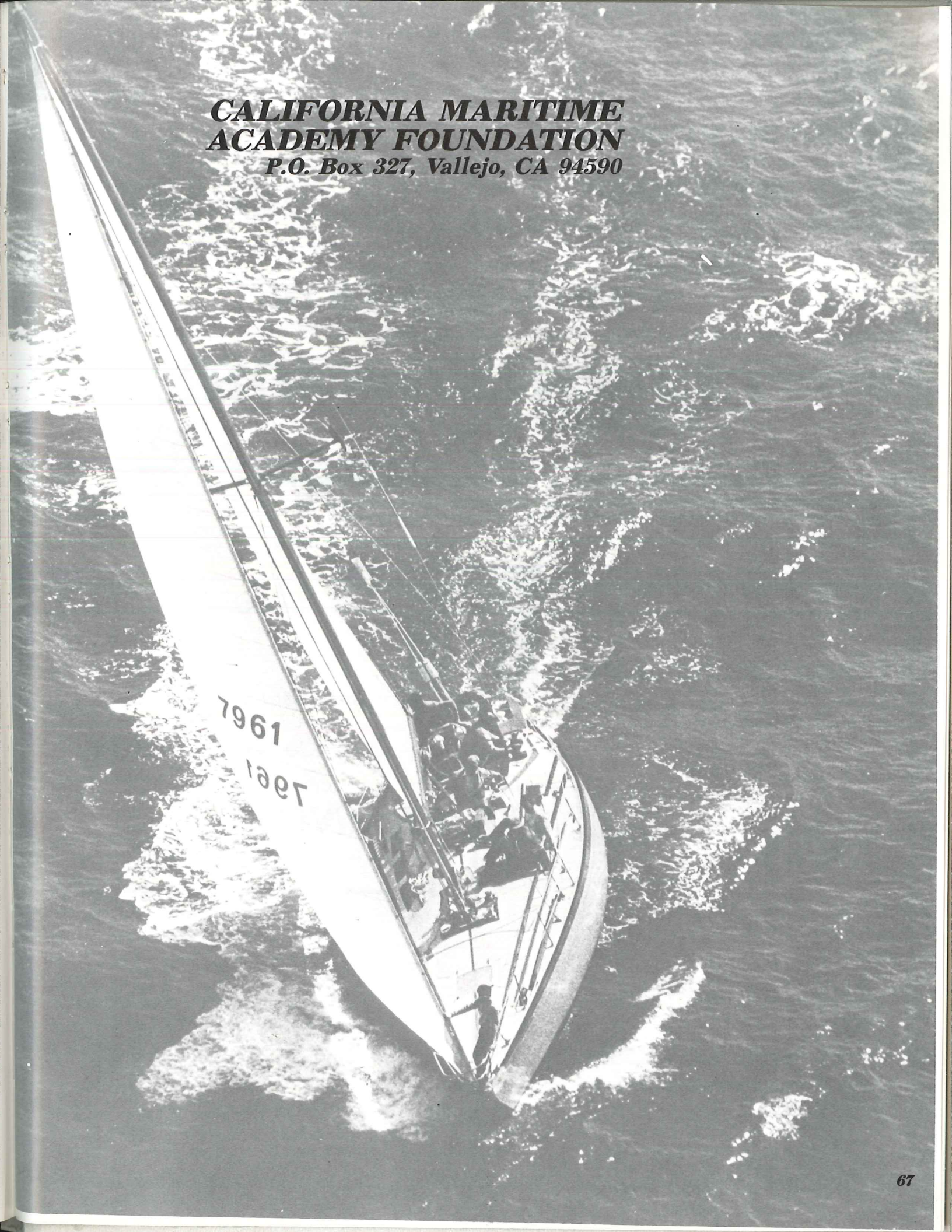

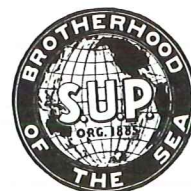
