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INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRECINCT WORKERS

1. The map shows the boundaries of your precinct.
2. Scratch off all voters labelled "A" -- these are registered Republicans.
3. List telephone numbers of all registered Democrats ("B") beside their name.
 - a. Call the Democrats in your precinct. Explain that you are working for Stevenson for president and inquire if they would like to take an active part in the campaign. Taken names of any such people and send them to Stevenson Headquarters.
4. Put each Democrat or Democratic family on a separate 3x5 card along with their street address.
 - a. Arrange these cards by street address (some might like to arrange by street address on a single sheet of paper putting the odd numbers in one column and the even in another making it possible to go down one side of the street and back the other hitting only the Democrats and thus saving time.)
 - b. When you have the Democrats of a precinct arranged in street order start contacting them.
 - c. Ask those Democrats who favor Stevenson to sign the petition in support of his candidacy and give a membership card to all those who do sign. Turn in completed petitions and any contributions to Stevenson Headquarters.
 - d. As literature for other Democratic candidates becomes available, distribute this also.
 - e. The Democratic candidates may wish to make a door to door campaign and will use your cards.
5. Although we want to win new supporters for Stevenson, try not to get slowed down too much by "talkers". Don't argue!
6. A few weeks before the June 5 primary, you will receive a precinct list brought up to date. Transfer telephone numbers to your new list and add telephone numbers for new voters. Bring your cards up-to-date and contact all new voters.
7. On election day, June 5, telephone all the Democrats reminding them to vote for Stevenson and other Democratic candidates.
8. After lunch on June 5 visit your polling place. On your precinct list, check off the names of those who have voted. Telephone remaining Democrats. Repeat this at 4:30. P.M.

The same instructions can pretty well apply for the November general election as well.
