The Chair led discussion on the 2006-2007 Project Planning Table. By general consensus minor adjustments to the plans were made.

Ruth Ann McAllister, District V, announced her resignation due to a schedule conflict over the next 12 months. Nancy Lee Phillips volunteered to serve as Treasurer for the balance of the term.

By general consent the May Agenda items are to also include: Appointment of the Treasurer; Creation of the Advisory Board; Report on ACCW Retreat; Forum Luncheon; Teleconferencing.

Several announcements were presented: 1) Multicultural Women of Achievement; 2) Elvia Guizar's son returning from Iraq.
