

Dear Mrs. Tolmach:

Thank you very much for the information, clippings and other material you sent us recently in connection with activities of certain military commanders in your area. I also appreciate your offer to send us a copy of the tape recording we discussed. If you have not had a chance to make a copy, we would be pleased to do so here and to return the original at once by air mail. That would permit us to audit the program and would assist us in arriving at a decision whether there exists a proper area for congressional investigation.

In our preliminary work, we have turned up a number of situations similar to the one that obtains in the Ventura/Oxnard area. We have not yet prepared a summary of our preliminary investigation on the basis of which Congressman Moss is to decide whether further investigation is needed. At such time as we do, I will be glad to let you know what further plans we have. In the meantime, I would appreciate your keeping us informed of any new developments and of your making available to us, as soon as possible, the tape recording.
