

Oxnard is the transportation center of the Central Coast with the only deep water commercial harbor between San Francisco and Los Angeles. At the junction of Ventura Freeway (U.S. 101) and Pacific Coast Highway (California 1) it is served by all truck lines and the Southern Pacific main rail line. The Ventura County Railroad serves the port and industrial areas. The Executive and Commercial County Airport at Oxnard, served by daily scheduled flights to San Francisco and Los Angeles, rounds out a complete transportation package that has been a major factor

that has been a major factor in attracting new industry.
The Federal Bureau of the Budget has designated Oxnard as one of the 13 Metropolitan areas of California. With over 60,000 residents, Oxnard is the largest city in Ventura County.





Year round balmy Ocean Breezes cool the summers with natural air conditioning and keep us frost free in January. Flowers and shrubs bloom all year and fresh fruit and vegetables grow right through the winter. Temperature varies less than twenty degrees from the year round 72 degree average.



School construction and community facilities have kept pace with growth. Two new High Schools, Junior High, Elementary Schools, Library, Recreation Center. Under construction or on the drawing board are a new Auditorium, City Hall, Elks Club, Senior Citizens Apartments, two Banks and a new golf course. A new State College is planned.
