Attorney General Lynch has asked me to request your participation on the Selection Committee of the Presidential Delegation which he will chair. I understand from prior conversations with you that you are willing to perform this responsibility.

The Selection Committee will commence its deliberation at 9:30 A. M., Saturday, February 17, in the Kent Room of the Airport Marina Hotel, 8601 Lincoln Boulevard, Los Angeles. Their telephone number is 670-8111 (area code 213).

It is expected that the job will take more than one day, so plan to be also available on the following day, February 18.

In the event you are able to be at the hotel Friday evening, I understand that National Committeewoman Ann Alanson will have hospitality in her suite. You can check with her on your arrival.

California has been allotted 172 full-vote delegates, plus, of course, the National Committeeman and National Committeewoman. We are also obliged to select 172 alternates. Generally, each Congressional District must have four resident delegates with the remaining number to be selected at large.
